### NOTICE 62 OF 2011

#### **The Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation And Tourism**

#### **Request for nominations for appointment as members to the North West:**

#### **Gambling Board**

The MEC for Economic Development, Environment, Conservation and Tourism, Ms Tebogo Modise, invites interested parties to submit nominations towards appointment of new members of the North West Gambling Board in terms of the provisions of section 5 of the North West Gambling Act No. 2 of 2001, as amended.

Section 5 provides that six (6) members of the Board will be appointed as follows:

- One member shall be qualified to be admitted to practice as a legal practitioner and after having so qualified, practiced as a legal practitioner or performed services related to the application or administration of the law
- One member shall be an accountant or auditor registered in terms of the Public Accountants' and Auditors' Act, 1991 (Act No. 80 of 1991), with experience in public practice as defined in section I of that Act
- One member shall be appointed by virtue of his or her knowledge and experience in the field of welfare or socio-economic development
- One member shall be appointed by virtue of his or her knowledge and active involvement in the tourism industry
- Two members shall be appointed on the basis of having either proven business acumen, a knowledge of the gambling industry, or who are otherwise suitable for appointment as members of the Board.

**The minimum requirements for nomination to these appointments are:**

- A nominee must be a South African citizen
- A nominee must not be a public servant, a Member of Parliament, any Provincial Legislature, Local Authority, or any Council, Commission or House of Traditional Leaders
- A nominee must not be a political office bearer
- A nominee must not have any direct or indirect interest in any gambling activity or any other business or enterprise that may conflict with the proper performance of his or her duties as a member of the Board.

In addition to the above minimum requirements, the nominee should not be disqualified from being a member of the Board in terms of the provisions of section 14 of the Act. Kindly, note further that the intended appointments will also take into consideration matters of equality in terms of gender, race, and disabilities as provided in the Constitution. Preference will in this regard be given to citizens of the North West Province.

#### **Nominations must be submitted in writing and must contain the following information:**

The name, residential address, postal address and telephone number of the nominee

- Elucidation of the reasons why the nominee is considered to be a fit and proper person to be appointed as a member of the Board
- The name, residential address, postal address and telephone number of the person making the nomination
- A written acceptance by the nominee together with a complete Curriculum Vitae must accompany each nomination.
