**DETERMINATION REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW  
PROVINCIAL DEPARTMENTS AND ALLOCATION AND TRANSFER OF  
FUNCTIONS FROM ONE DEPARTMENT TO ANOTHER**

Pursuant to the 2014 National and Provincial elections, I, **Supra Obakeng Ramoeletsi Mahumapelo**, in my capacity as the Premier of the North West Province, have reconfigured the provincial departments as a result of which the structure and composition of government departments became affected.

In terms of section 137 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 read with Section 3A(b) of the Public Service Act, 1994 (Proclamation no. 103 of 1994), I have determined the establishment of new departments including the transfer and allocation of functions between departments as set out in the schedule below:

<p><b>Department of Finance</b></p>	<p><b>Provincial Treasury</b></p> <p>This Department has undergone a name change from <b>Department of Finance</b> to <b>Provincial Treasury</b>.</p> <p><i>Provincial Treasury function now becomes a Department under the portfolio of MEC for Finance and Enterprise Development.</i></p> <p><i>It must be noted that Provincial Treasury functions as well as the designation of the Political Head thereof are determined in terms of section 17 and 18 of PFMA.</i></p>
<p><b>Department of Sport, Arts and Culture</b></p>	<p><b>Department of Culture, Arts and Traditional Affairs</b></p> <p><i>The function of Traditional Affairs has been transferred from the former Department of Local Government and Traditional Affairs to the above mentioned Department whilst the function of Sports excluding Recreation has been transferred from the former</i></p>

	<p><i>Department of Sport, Arts and Culture to the current Department of Education and Sports Development.</i></p> <p><i>The function of Recreation is retained as one of the functions of the above mentioned Department.</i></p>
<p><b>Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation and Tourism</b></p>	<p><b>Department of Tourism</b></p> <p>This is a new Department established from the former <b>Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation and Tourism.</b></p> <p><i>The function of Tourism which was part of the former Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation and Tourism has now been elevated to a new Department as above mentioned.</i></p>
