PROCLAMATION BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA

NATIONAL PROSECUTING AUTHORITY ACT, 1998

Determination of Powers, Duties and Functions of a Special Director of Public Prosecutions

Under section 13(1)(c) of the National Prosecuting Authority Act, 1998 (Act No. 32 of 1998), I, hereby confer, impose and assign the following powers, duties and functions on or to MRS KALYANI PILLAY, a Special Director of Public Prosecutions in the Office of the National Director of Public Prosecutions, appointed in terms of the said provisions:

- (a) To provide legal advice to the National Director regarding specific legal and administrative issues.
- (b) To manage special national projects and operations as per the directives of the National Director.
- (c) To provide strategic inputs in matters brought before the National Director.
- (d) To compile business intelligence reports to assist the National Director to make strategic decisions.
- (e) To manage the relationship between the Office of the National Director, government departments, Parliament and external agencies.

- (f) To prepare such briefs, presentations, speeches and documents as required by the National Director.
- (g) Generally, to give such advice or rendering such assistance to the National Director as may be required to exercise the powers, carry out the duties and perform the functions which are conferred or imposed on or assigned to the National Director by the Constitution or any other law.
