The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice, in terms of the provisions of section 55 (2) of the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act, No 153 of 1993, as amended, that it has received an application from The Greater Middelburg Community Radio for the amendment of its community sound broadcasting licence in terms of section 52(1)(c) Act.
