- Other relevant matters



GENERAL INFORMATION

A person to be nominated must: be fit and proper to hold office as a member and have appropriate qualifications and experience in the areas of conservation, biodiversity management, tourism development, human resource management or financial and business practice, or otherwise possess special insight in relation to any aspect of the activities of SA National Parks.

A person holding office as a member of Parliament or a provincial legislature or has been removed from office in terms of section 65 of the Act, may not be appointed as a member of the Board.
