PROVISIONAL PROTECTION OF THE HISTORICAL HUMAN BURIALS SITUATED WITHIN THE GREEN POINT AND WEST CITY AREA

By virtue of the powers vested in the South African Heritage Resources Agency in terms of section 29 (1) of the National Heritage Resources Act no 25 of 1999 (the Act), read with section 29 (1) (a) (iii) of the Act, the burials and human remains situated in the geographic area fully described hereunder are hereby provisionally protected for a period of six months for the purposes of further investigation in terms of burials generally managed under section 36.

Description

The heritage resource comprising burials and human remains, situated in the geographic area described in the schedule below.

SCHEDULE

The heritage resource proposed for provisional protection is the human burials situated in the area demarcated below:

From the corner of Strand and Bree Streets, northwest to Buitengracht Street, southwest to Longmarket Street, northwest to the top of Longmarket Street, northeast to a point just north of the Tana Baru Historical Burial Site, and then in a straight line running southeast to the corner of Chiappini and Hout Streets. Then from there northeast to the corner of Chiappini and Strand Streets, then northwest to the intersection of Strand and Vos Streets, northeast to the intersection of Vos and Waterkant Streets, turning northwest on Wate ' rkant and along a line that follows Waterkant, Rawbone and Braemar Roads to Upper Portswood Road. Then from there northeast along Portswood Road to intersect the historical coastline, and then southeast, past Jetty 1, following the historical coastline to and along the Old Dock Road to the Hans Strydom and Bree Streets intersection, and finally southwest along Bree Street to the corner of Strand and Bree Streets, including the street reserves.
