#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Please note that no member of the government of the Republic of South Africa or of a provincial government, or employee of the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa or of the legislature of any province, or officer or employee of the government of any province shall be appointed as a member of the Board of South African Tourism.

Nominations shall be persons who possess appropriate knowledge and/or experience in the areas of tourism development, marketing, human resource management or finance and business practice, or otherwise possess expertise in relation to any aspect of the activities of South African Tourism. Women and people living with disabilities are encouraged to be nominated.
