 of the Cape) for the renewal of its community sound broadcasting licence in
 terms of section 44(1). The details of the application are contained in the

- 4. Persons who lodge representations in terms hereof, must simultaneously indicate whether they also require an opportunity to make oral representations to the Authority.
- 5. Persons who lodge representations in terms hereof, shall at the time of lodgement furnish proof to the satisfaction of the Authority that a copy of the representation has been delivered by hand to Mr. Imam Alli, Station Manager, Voice of the Cape, 2 Queens Park Avenue Salt River 7925, or sent by registered post to P.O. Box 16210, Vlaeberg 8018 or faxed to (021) 447 7271.
- 6. Voice of the Cape shall be entitled to respond in writing to written representations made by interested persons on the proposed renewal, and such written response must be lodged with the Authority within sixty (60) days of the date of publication of this notice in the Government Gazette. Voice of the Cape must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of such response by

hand, or has sent a copy of such response by registered mail or by facsimile to the relevant person having made such written representations.
