## SCHEDULE 1

### Definitions

#### 1. (1) In these Regulations:

"Area measuring instrument" means a measuring instrument that is designed and constructed to measure and automatically indicate the superficial area of leather or other approved materials passed through it.

"Automatic weighing instrument" means a massmeter provided with a self-acting mechanism for-

- a) the measurement of the mass of predetermined quantities of materials, the feed to and delivery from the load receptor being automatically controlled;
- b) the measurement of the mass of quantities of materials approximately predetermined and the recording and summation of the actual mass of the quantities measured, the feed to and delivery from the load receptor being automatically controlled;
- c) the measurement of the mass of any material passed intermittently or in a continuous stream over the load receptor that may be in the form of a conveyor belt, and the automatic summation of the mass of such material; or
- d) the performing of any function similar to those referred to in a), b) and c) of this definition.

"Conventional measure of volume" means a measure of conventional design used for measuring liquid substances having a datum level or levels which define the quantity or quantities which can be measured by means thereof and which conforms to the applicable requirements of the Trade Metrology Act but which does not require type approval in terms of section 18 thereof.

"In motion weighing system for vehicles" means a massmeter for the determination of the mass of vehicles while in motion.

"Length measuring instrument" means a measuring instrument that is designed and constructed to measure and automatically indicate the length of fabrics or other approved materials passed through it.

"liquid fuel dispenser" means a measuring assembly comprising a pump, meter and ancillary equipment for the measurement and delivery of liquids, including liquid petroleum gas, as approved during type approval into the tanks of vehicles, boats or small aircraft or into other receptacles.

"liquid measuring device" means an apparatus for delivering predetermined volumes of liquid into drums, barrels, bottles or other receptacles, but excluding a liquid fuel dispenser and any liquid meter for predetermined quantities.

"Liquid meter" means a measuring assembly other than a liquid fuel dispenser comprising a meter and ancillary equipment for the measurement of liquids other than water as approved during type approval.

"Masspiece for fine measurement" means a masspiece used with a massmeter for pharmaceutical dispensing or the measurement of precious metals, precious stones and comparable goods.

"Masspiece for course measurement" means a masspiece used with a massmeter for the measurement of general goods not required to be measured using masspieces for fine measurement.

"Non-automatic weighing Instrument" means a massmeter that requires the intervention of an operator during the weighing process, for example to deposit on or remove from the load receptor the load to be measured and also to obtain the result.

"Vehicle scale" means a non automatic massmeter for the determination of the mass of rail or road vehicles and having a load receptor in the form of a rail track or of a platform or platforms or a combination of these on to which rail or road vehicles may be moved for the measurement of their mass.

"Vehicle tank" means a receptacle which mayor may not be subdivided into two or more compartments, the tank or each compartment having a capacity of not less than 200 L, mounted on a motor truck or trailer and provided with a single datum level or a removable gauge, which is graduated to indicate various volumes, for the measurement for the quantity of a liquid contained in the tank or a compartment thereof.

(2) All the measuring instruments, or classes or kinds of such measuring instruments defined in this Schedule and mentioned in column 1 of Schedule 2, must be verified, certified or recertified by the date specified in column 3, unless they were verified, certified or recertified before that date and within the period specified in column 2. Thereafter such measuring instruments must be reverified or recertified at intervals not exceeding the intervals specified in column 2 and determined from the date of last verification, certification or recertification.

(3) A conventional measuring instrument of volume made of clear glass and a conventional measuring instrument of length made of a material prescribed by regulation must be verified or certified before being taken into use and thereafter only on the instruction of an inspector if he has reasonable grounds for believing that it has been altered materially since it was verified or certified, or unless the original stamp of verification or certification has been defaced or has become illegible.

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## PORK INDUSTRY -

- REQUEST FOR THE INTRODUCTION OF STATUTORY MEASURES RELATING TO LEVIES, REGISTRATION AND RECORDS & RETURNS
  - DIRECTLY AFFECTED GROUPS ARE INVITED TO FORWARD ANY COMMENTS REGARDING THE PROPOSED STATUTORY MEASURES
- 

It is hereby made known that in terms of section 11 of the Marketing of Agricultural Products Act, 1996 (Act No. 47 of 1996), the Minister of Agriculture has received a request from the pork industry for the continuation of statutory measures relating to levies, registration, the keeping of records and the rendering of returns.

The South African Pork Producers' Organisation (SAPPO), on behalf of the directly affected groups in the pork industry applied for these statutory measures. The current statutory measures for the pork industry were introduced on 5 November 2005 and will expire on 4 November 2007. SAPPO requested ministerial approval for the continuation of these statutory measures for a new period of three years, to lapse on 31 October 2010.

The purpose of the statutory measures relating to registration and records & returns is to compel abattoirs to register with SAPPO and also to compel abattoirs to keep records and render the returns to SAPPO. It is envisaged that SAPPO will outsource some of the functions relating to the administration of the proposed statutory measures. These statutory measures will enable SAPPO to process and disseminate accurate information to all role-players in order for them to make informed decisions.

The SAPPO proposed a statutory levy of R6.00 per slaughter pig (VAT excluded) for the three year period. This levy will replace the current levy of R5.20 per slaughter pig (VAT excluded) which will be collected until 31 October 2007.

The statutory levy will finance the following functions -

- Empowerment and development of black emerging pork producers
- Customer education
- Consumer assurance
- Research and development
- Industry information and liaison
- Administration

It is envisaged that the pork industry would collect an amount of approximately R11.4 million per annum to finance the above-mentioned functions.

As the proposed statutory measures requested by SAPPO are *prima facie* consistent with the objectives of the Marketing of Agricultural Products Act, No 49 of 1996, the Minister requested the National Agricultural Marketing Council on 28 March 2007 to investigate the possible implementation of the relevant statutory measures and to report back to her within 60 days.

Directly affected groups in the pork industry are kindly requested to submit any comments regarding the proposed statutory measures to the National Agricultural Marketing Council within 14 days of the publication hereof.
