SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In this Schedule "the Regulations" mean the regulations published by Government Notice No. R. 980 of 17 August 2004.

Amendment of regulation 15 of the Regulations

2. Regulation 15 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for sub-regulation (6) of the following sub-regulation:

"(6) When the applicant has paid the initial annual registration fee, as set out in [Form NLA 8] Table NLA 4, the National Liquor Authority must deliver a registration certificate in Form NLA 9 to the registrant."

Insertion of regulation 15A in the Regulations

3. The following regulation is hereby inserted in the Regulations after regulation 15:

"15A. Annual renewal of registration

(1) Upon receipt of a Notice for annual renewal of the registrant's registration on Form 32, a registrant must submit the Registrants annual information return on Form NLA 28 and pay the annual renewal fee as set out in Table NLA 4, within a period contemplated in regulation 11(4).

(2) When the registrant has submitted the Registrants annual information return and paid the annual renewal fee as contemplated in sub-regulation (1), the National Liquor Authority must deliver an Annual renewal certificate in Form NLA 33 to the registrant."
