

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RULES REGULATING THE CONDUCT OF THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE ORANGE FREE STATE PROVINCIAL DIVISION OF THE HIGH COURT OF SOUTH AFRICA

1. Definitions

In these rules unless the context otherwise indicates –

'court' shall mean the Orange Free State Provincial Division of the High Court of South Africa;

'finalise', for the purposes of Rule 3.3(a), shall mean that in respect of each case appearing on the provisional term list all the parties to a particular case shall agree upon a date of trial, failing which the registrar shall be obliged at the said meeting to assign such date of trial as the registrar deems reasonable in the circumstances, which date may be in a later term;

'uniform rules' shall mean the rules regulating the conduct of the proceedings of the several provincial and local divisions of the High Court of South Africa, promulgated by Government Notice R48, dated 12 January 1965, as amended;

and a word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the uniform rules shall bear that meaning.

2. Sittings of the Court and Administrative Recesses

- 2.1 There shall be four terms in each year. The judge president shall, by notice in the Government Gazette published not later than 30 September of each year, fix the dates of such terms and administrative recesses in respect of the ensuing calendar year.
- 2.2 The periods intervening between the said terms shall be periods of administrative recess during which the ordinary business of the court shall be suspended, but one or more officers of the registrar's office shall attend daily for the dispatch of all necessary business. One of the judges will attend at chambers during such administrative recess on any day for which in urgent cases attendance may be specially desired to hear and decide all applications and motions including interdicts and orders for summary redress.
- 2.3 All courts shall commence at 9h30, save that applications for leave to appeal will as a rule be set down for hearing at 9h00.

3. Setting down of Defended Cases for Trial

- 3.1 When the pleadings in any trial action have been closed, the plaintiff, or if the plaintiff fails to do so within two weeks of the close of the pleadings, the defendant, may apply for a trial date by entering the required particulars in the register kept by the registrar and such plaintiff or defendant or their attorney shall within three days deliver a notice in writing to the opposite party that this has been done.

- 3.2 The registrar shall compile a list, known as the provisional term list, of cases to be tried in each term during each civil term and shall enter therein in the chronological order in which the entries were effected in terms of subrule (1), so many cases for trial on specific dates as the registrar considers can be tried during the term to which the list relates.
- 3.3 (a) The registrar shall publish the provisional term list not later than four months prior to the first day of the term to which the list relates. The said list shall be finalised at a meeting held in the registrar's office within four weeks of its publication as aforesaid.
- (b) Within seven days of finalisation of the provisional term list as aforesaid, the party applying for the date of trial shall formally set the matter down for hearing by delivering a notice of set-down and in the event of that party failing to do so, any other party to the said proceedings may within three days deliver such notice of set-down. In the event of no party delivering a notice of set-down within the aforementioned period, the case shall be removed from the term list and the registrar shall be free to reallocate such date or dates to any other case next on the awaiting-trial case appearing on the register.
- (c) In the event of any matter on the list being settled or removed from the list, the registrar may allocate such date or dates falling vacant to the next available awaiting-trial case appearing on the register.
- (d) No notice of set-down shall be delivered in terms of this rule less than three months prior to the date of hearing without the consent of the opposite party.

4. Indexing and Pagination of Civil Cases set down for Trial

- 4.1 The pleadings in a civil trial shall be indexed, paginated and bound by the party setting the case down not less than three weeks before the date of set-down.
- 4.2 The pleadings bundle shall contain:
- (i) Summons and particulars of claim or declaration
 - (ii) Plea
 - (iii) Replication and duplication (if any)
 - (iv) The minutes of the Rule 37 conference

in that order.

There may be a second indexed bundle containing notices and interlocutory applications.

- 4.3 Where expert notices have been filed, there shall be a separate indexed and paginated bundle containing expert notices and summaries.

5. Pre-trial conference

- 5.1 In addition to the matters mentioned in Uniform Rule 37, the pre-trial minute shall contain a statement detailing what the important issues in the action are which have to be adjudicated.
- 5.2.1 A party may request that a pre-trial conference be held before a judge in terms of Uniform Rule 37(8), and such party must then request the registrar in writing to ask the presiding judge (if already appointed) or any other judge designated by the judge president, to convene and hold such conference.
- 5.2.2 A request to hold such special pre-trial conference will only be acceded to in exceptional circumstances and after full reasons have been furnished.

6. Settlement of trial or withdrawal from the Roll

- 6.1 A case may be withdrawn from the roll of cases for trial on such conditions as may be agreed upon between the parties, by addressing a notice in writing, signed by all the parties or their attorneys, to the registrar.
- 6.2 Subject to the provisions of subrule (1), a case may be withdrawn from the roll only with the consent of the court and on such terms as to the court may seem just.
- 6.3 Whenever a case is settled out of court, or the parties agree to postpone it, the attorney for the party who placed the case on the roll shall forthwith notify the registrar of such fact and shall file, as soon as possible thereafter, a notice of withdrawal or postponement.
- 6.4 Where an order by agreement is sought in a matter on the roll of cases for trial for which no judge has yet been assigned, such matter shall be placed before the duty judge who shall dispose of it.

7. Motion Court

- 7.1 In and out of term every Thursday, (or if such Thursday is not a court day, then the next succeeding court day), is reserved for hearing of applications, motions, provisional and default cases.
- 7.2 All applications, notices of set-down, affidavits and all other documents for the motion court on Thursday must be filed with the registrar before 12 noon on the Friday immediately preceding the motion day, or, if such Friday is a public holiday, on the court day immediately preceding such holiday.
- 7.3 All opposed applications shall be set down in term every Thursday. Out of term opposed applications may be heard as a matter of urgency on Thursday or any other day as directed by the judge president or in the discretion of the presiding judge.

- 7.4 All opposed applications must be indexed, paginated and bound at the time of set-down.
- 7.5 All unopposed matters are called in the sequence in which they appear on the roll prepared by the registrar, provided that divorces are only called after the applications have been disposed of, provided further that senior counsel will be entitled to call all their unopposed applications and divorces in order of their seniority before all other legal representatives.
- 7.6 If a legal practitioner appears in two opposed applications on a motion court day, and if those two opposed applications are not heard by the same judge, the application heard by the senior judge will be heard first, unless such senior judge has made another arrangement.
- 7.7 A legal practitioner who appears in the unopposed motion court will also be entitled to appear in opposed rule 43 applications.
- 7.8 No legal representative will be permitted on a motion court day to appear in both unopposed applications (including divorces) and in opposed applications.
- 7.9 No legal representative may appear in more than two opposed applications and a legal representative appearing in two opposed applications, shall not be entitled to appear in a Rule 43 application.
- 7.10 A legal representative appearing in only one opposed motion shall be entitled to appear in not more than three Rule 43 applications.
- 7.11 Where an opposed application will, in terms of an agreement between the parties, be postponed or become unopposed because of a settlement or other reason, the following position pertains:
 - (a) The judge who was to have heard the application shall be informed of the agreement by the attorneys of the parties immediately personally or via the judge's secretary.
 - (b) The application will be called before this judge in court (before the other opposed matters) at 9h30, unless an order is granted in chambers.
 - (c) The legal representatives who would have appeared in the matter, and who do not have other opposed cases, are, after the aforesaid agreement, no longer subject to the provisions relating to opposed matters set out above.
- 7.12 Where an attorney has an unopposed application of such nature that he requires (because of the importance or ambit thereof) that it be dealt with by a particular counsel, the attorney requests the judge president by means of a letter (delivered together with the notice of set down) to set down the application in the court for opposed applications and it is then deemed to be an opposed application for purposes of this rule.
- 7.13 Where a legal representative is in terms of these rules entitled to appear in two courts, such legal representative must ensure that such appearances/instructions do not have the effect that the proceedings in

any of the courts are delayed because of such appearances/instructions.

- 7.14 Where the parties to an opposed divorce case conclude a deed of settlement, such deed of settlement should normally be made available to the family advocate to consider and approve the arrangements regarding custody of the minor children concerned.

8. Default Judgments

- 8.1 Where declaring property executable or eviction is requested the practice note issued by the Supreme Court of Appeal in **Standard Bank of SA Ltd v Saunderson and Others** 2006(2) SA 264 (SCA) at 277D-E must be complied with.
- 8.2 Where damages are claimed by default, oral evidence is normally required, but the trial judge may accept evidence by way of affidavit if circumstances justify it.

9. Sequestrations

- 9.1 All cash amounts paid by or on behalf of the respondent in an application for compulsory sequestration or by an applicant for voluntary surrender must be paid into the Guardian's Fund and the Master's report must state whether that has in fact been done.
- 9.2 No application for a final sequestration order will be heard unless the Master's report which shall be obtained specifically for such application, has been placed before the court.

Note: The Master insists that the provisions of section 19(1) of the Insolvency Act regarding an inventory be properly complied with by Sheriffs, and such inventory must therefore be furnished to the Master as soon as possible. The Master will not issue a report before such inventory has been provided to him. If the absence of such inventory has the effect that the rule nisi is not confirmed, an explanation for the absence will have to be provided and a suitable costs order can be considered.

- 9.3 Every rule nisi in a compulsory sequestration application shall be returnable after four weeks, unless the court otherwise directs.
- 9.4.1 All applications for provisional sequestration and voluntary surrender will be approached by this Court on the basis that the costs of sequestration and administration will amount to R20 000. (This amount may be adjusted from time to time.)
- 9.4.2 If the applicant is of the opinion that those costs will be less in a particular matter, an estimate thereof must be attached to the application papers and that estimate must be placed before the Master, who shall provide comments thereon to the Court.
- 9.5 In applications for rehabilitation all curators shall furnish a copy of their reports to both the Master and the Court, even if they have nothing to

bring to the attention of the Master or the Court. In other words, even where they have nothing to report on, they must bring that fact to the attention of the Master or the Court.

10. Exceptions and Interpleaders

Exceptions and Interpleaders shall be set down for hearing on a Friday. Heads of argument in interpleaders must be filed no later than 15h00 on the Tuesday preceding the day of hearing, and in terms of Rule 13.4 with regard to exceptions.

11. Rule 43 Applications

- 11.1 Rule 43 applications are set down for hearing at 9h30 and are normally heard from 14h15.
- 11.2 Both parties and their attorneys must be present at court on the morning of the hearing and attempt to resolve the disputes between the parties, and, if possible, to settle the divorce action, in which case the court before which the Rule 43 application was set down, shall hear the divorce action.
- 11.3 If the matter has not been settled by 14h15, the Rule 43 will be argued forthwith.
- 11.4 The judge presiding at the Rule 43 application may agree that the matter be called before 14h15 if both legal representatives are available and no other court is inconvenienced.

12. Appeals and Reviews

- 12.1 During term every Monday is reserved for the hearing of appeals and reviews: Provided that criminal appeals and reviews may also be set down for hearing during recess periods upon the instructions of the judge president.
- 12.2 Reviews are normally heard by two judges.

13. Heads of argument

13.1 Criminal Appeals from Magistrates' Court

Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 51(4) of the Uniform Rules of Court the periods within which heads of argument are to be delivered in all criminal appeals from the magistrates' court are: -

- (a) by the appellant not less than 15 court days before the appeal is heard; and
- (b) by the respondent not less than 10 court days before the appeal is heard.

13.2 Civil Appeals from Magistrates' Court

Uniform Rule of Court 50(9) applies. [15 and 10 days respectively.]

13.3 Opposed Motions

Heads of argument in all opposed applications, except Rule 43 applications, must be filed with the registrar no later than 15h00 on the Tuesday immediately preceding the motion day, or, if such Tuesday is a public holiday, on the court day immediately preceding such holiday.

13.4 Reviews under Rule 53 and Exceptions

Heads of argument in all Rule 53 reviews and exceptions must be filed at the registrar:

- (a) by the applicant/excipient not less than 15 court days before the date of hearing; and
- (b) by the respondent not less than 10 court days before the date of hearing.

13.5 Full Bench Civil and Criminal Appeals

Uniform Rules 49(15) [15 and 10 days] and 49A(3) and (4) [20 and 5 days] respectively apply.

13.6 Format

All heads of argument shall be clearly and legibly printed in black, double-spaced, on one side only of good quality A4 size white paper.

14. Striking off the Roll

- 14.1 If a matter is struck off the roll on the ground of non-appearance of a party, it is regarded as finally disposed of and can be reinstated upon presentation of an explanation under oath as to why there was no appearance.
- 14.2 Once an Appeal has been struck off the roll, the registrar returns the record to the clerk of the court.
- 14.3.1 In all criminal appeals where the appellant's heads of argument have not been handed in on the date when the *dies* therefore have expired, the state may request that the appeal be struck off the roll because of such failure.
- 14.3.2 An application for striking off does not affect the discretion of the court to deal with the appeal and/or an application for condonation, which includes hearing the appeal or deciding it by virtue of the Court's inherent review powers.
- 14.3.3 Where the state has applied for the striking off of an appeal, but thereafter an application for condonation of the appellant's failure is filed and/or where heads of argument are then filed by the appellant, the state also has to file heads of argument, even though the appellant's heads of argument were not timeously filed.
- 14.3.4 Where the state has applied for the striking off of the appeal and where no condonation application and/or heads of argument were filed by the

appellant, the state is not obliged to file heads of argument unless the presiding judge requests the state to do so.

15. Bail Appeals

- 15.1 All bail appeals are urgent and are finalised as soon as possible.
- 15.2 Upon receipt of a bail appeal the registrar places it before the duty judge who shall dispose of it
- (a) by hearing it himself; or
 - (b) by placing it on the roll for hearing as soon as possible, after consultation with the judge president.
- 15.3 The duty judge decides whether and when heads of argument have to be filed.

16. Applications for Leave to Appeal from the High Court in Civil Matters

- 16.1 It is the duty of the applicant for leave to appeal to obtain a copy of the judgment against which the application is brought and to take all steps necessary to prosecute the appeal.
- 16.2 The judgment must be filed with the registrar by the applicant not later than one month after the application has been filed.
- 16.3 As soon as the judgment has been filed with the registrar, the registrar must within one week request suitable dates from the judge involved and thereafter arrange a date suitable to all and the matter must be set down by the applicant in accordance therewith.
- 16.4 Applications for leave to appeal will be set down for hearing at 9h00 on a Friday, or any other day and time that the judge agrees to.

17. Applications for Leave to Appeal from the High Court in Criminal Matters

- 17.1 Where the registrar receives an application for leave to appeal within the time allowed under section 316(1)(b) of the Criminal Procedure Act 51 of 1977 (14 ordinary days after the passing of sentence) the normal procedure follows.
- 17.2 Where an appellant lodges an application for leave to appeal in person, the registrar transmits that application to the Legal Aid Board which then, after requesting a date, sets the application down for hearing in consultation with the DPP.
- 17.3 Applications for leave to appeal are set down for hearing at 9h00 on a Friday, or any other day and time that the judge agrees to.

18. Dress code

When legal practitioners appear in the High Court, they must be dressed in accordance with the following guidelines:

A. Counsel

Counsel's robes and bib. Men wear dark trousers. Ladies wear a dark skirt or long trousers and appropriate shoes (not sandals).

B. Attorneys

Attorney's robes. Men wear a dark suit, white shirt and conservative tie. Ladies wear a white blouse with a collar and a dark skirt or long trousers and appropriate shoes (not sandals).

19. Repeal

Government Notice R3290 of 12 September 1969 and all its amendments and all practice directions issued prior to the date on which these amended rules come into operation, are hereby repealed.

1. Definisies

In hierdie reëls, tensy uit die samehang anders blyk, beteken –

‘afhandel’, vir die doeleindes van Reël 3.3(a), dat met betrekking tot elke saak wat voorkom op die voorlopige termynlys al die partye tot ‘n besondere saak sal ooreenkom op ‘n verhoordatum, by gebreke waarvan die griffier verplig sal wees om by die genoemde vergadering ‘n verhoordatum te bepaal wat die griffier as redelik beskou in die omstandighede, welke datum in ‘n latere termyn mag wees;

‘eenvormige reëls’ die reëls waarby die verrigtinge van die verskillende provinsiale en plaaslike afdelings van die Hooggeregshof van Suid-Afrika gereël word en wat by Goewermentskennisgewing R48 van 12 Januarie 1965 afgekondig is, soos gewysig;

‘hof’ die Oranje Vrystaatse Provinsiale Afdeling van die Hooggeregshof van Suid-Afrika.

en het ‘n woord of uitdrukking waaraan ‘n betekenis in die eenvormige reëls geheg is, daardie betekenis.

2. Sittings van die Hof en Administratiewe Resesse

2.1 Daar is vier sittingstermyne in elke jaar vir die afhandeling van siviele- en strafaangeleenthede. Die regter-president bepaal, deur kennisgewing in die Staatskoerant gepubliseer nie later nie as 30 September van elke jaar, die datums van sodanige termynen ten opsigte van die daaropvolgende kalenderjaar.

2.2 Die tydperke tussen voormelde termynen is tydperke van administratiewe reses wanneer die gewone werksaamhede van die Hof opgeskort word, maar een of meer amptenare van die griffierskantoor moet daaglik teenwoordig wees om alle nodige werksaamhede af te handel. Een van die regters sal op kamerhof aanwesig wees op enige dag gedurende die administratiewe reses wanneer, in dringende gevalle, dit spesiaal nodig mag wees om alle aansoeke, mosies, interdikte ingesluit, en bevele vir summiere regsverligting, te verhoor.

2.3 Alle howe begin om 9.30 behalwe dat aansoeke vir verlof om te appelleer in die gewone loop van sake geplaas sal word vir verhoor om 9 uur.

3. Terrolleplasing van Verdedigde Sake vir Verhoor

3.1 Wanneer die pleitstukke in enige verhoorsaak gesluit is, kan die eiser, of indien die eiser versuim om dit binne twee weke na die sluiting van die pleitstukke te doen, die verweerder, aansoek doen om ‘n verhoordatum deur die verlangde besonderhede in die register te skryf wat deur die griffier gehou word en so ‘n eiser of verweerder of die

prokureur van so 'n eiser of verweerder moet binne drie dae 'n skriftelike kennisgewing aan die teenparty aflewer dat dit gedoen is.

- 3.2 Die griffier stel 'n lys op, bekend as die voorlopige termynlys, van sake wat gedurende elke termyn tydens 'n siviele sittingstermyn verhoor staan te word en plaas daarop in die chronologiese volgorde waarin die inskrywings ingevolge sub-reël (1) gemaak is, soveel sake vir verhoor op bepaalde datums van die termyn as wat die griffier van oordeel is gedurende die termyn waarop die lys betrekking het, verhoor kan word.
- 3.3 (a) Die griffier publiseer die voorlopige termynlys minstens vier maande voor die eerste dag van die termyn waarop dit betrekking het. Sodanige lys word afgehandel by 'n vergadering wat binne vier weke vanaf voormelde publikasie in die griffier se kantoor gehou word.
- (b) Binne sewe dae vanaf afhandeling van voormelde voorlopige termynlys moet die party wat aansoek om die verhoordatum gedoen het, formeel die geding ter rolle plaas vir verhoor deur 'n kennisgewing van terrolleplasing af te lewer en indien daardie party versuim om dit te doen, kan enige ander party tot genoemde geding binne drie dae sodanige kennisgewing van terrolleplasing aflewer. Indien geen party 'n kennisgewing van terrolleplasing binne die voormelde tydperk aflewer nie, word die saak van die termynlys verwyder en staan dit die griffier vry om sodanige datum of datums aan enige ander geding eerste op die verhoorafwagtende register toe te ken.
- (c) Indien enige geding op die rol geskik of van die rol verwyder word, mag die griffier sodanige datum of datums wat oopval aan die volgende verhoorafwagtende geding in die register toeken.
- (d) Geen kennisgewing van terrolleplasing ingevolge hierdie reël word minder as drie maande voor die datum van verhoor afgelewer sonder die toestemming van die teenparty nie.

4. Indeks en Paginering van Siviele Sake geplaas vir Verhoor

- 4.1 Die pleitstukke in 'n siviele saak moet geïndekseer, gepagineer en gebind word deur die party wat die saak plaas vir verhoor nie minder nie as drie weke voor die datum van plasing.
- 4.2 Die pleitstukke bundel moet die volgende bevat:
- (i) Dagvaarding en besonderhede van eis of deklarasie
 - (ii) Verweerskrif
 - (iii) Replikasie en duplikasie (indien enige)
 - (iv) Die notule van die Reël 37 konferensie

in daardie volgorde.

Daar mag 'n tweede geïndekseerde bundel wees wat kennisgewings en interlokutêre aansoeke bevat.

- 4.3 Waar deskundige kennisgewings geliasseer is, moet daar 'n afsonderlike geïndekseerde en gepagineerde bundel wees wat deskundige kennisgewings en opsommings bevat.

5. Voorverhoor Konferensie

- 5.1 Bykomstig tot die aangeleentheid genoem in Eenvormige Hofreël 37 moet die voorverhoor notule 'n stelling bevat wat uiteensit wat die belangrike kwessies in die aksie is wat bereg moet word.

- 5.2.1 'n Party mag voorstel dat 'n voorverhoor konferensie voor 'n regter moet plaasvind in terme van Eenvormige Hofreël 37(8) en sodanige party moet dan die griffier skriftelik versoek om die voorsittende regter (indien reeds aangewys) of enige ander regter wat deur die regter-president aangewys word, te vra om so 'n konferensie te belê en te hou.

- 5.2.2 So 'n versoek word slegs in buitengewone omstandighede toegestaan en nadat volledige redes daarvoor verstrekkend is.

6. Skikking van Verhoor of Verwydering van die Rol

- 6.1 'n Saak mag van die rol van sake vir verhoor verwyder word op sodanige voorwaardes as waarop die partye mag ooreenkom, deur 'n skriftelike kennisgewing, onderteken deur die partye of hulle prokureurs, aan die griffier te rig.

- 6.2 Behoudens die bepalings van subreël (1), word 'n saak van die rol verwyder slegs met verlof van die hof en op sodanige voorwaardes as wat die hof doenlik ag.

- 6.3 Wanneer 'n saak buite die hof geskik word, of wanneer die partye ooreenkom op 'n uitstel daarvan, stel die prokureur van die party wat die saak ter rolle geplaas het die griffier onverwyld daarvan in kennis en liasseer so spoedig doenlik daarna 'n kennisgewing van terugtrekking of uitstel.

- 6.4 Waar 'n bevel by ooreenkoms gevra word in 'n saak op die verhoorrol waar geen regter nog aangewys is nie, word die lêer na die diensregter geneem wat dit dan afhandel.

7. Mosiehof

- 7.1 Gedurende en buite sittingstermyne word elke Donderdag (of as dit nie 'n hofdag is nie, dan die eersvolgende hofdag), vir die verhoor van aansoeke, mosies, dagvaardings, voorlopige gedinge en gedinge by verstek voorbehou.

- 7.2 Alle aansoeke, kennisgewings van terrolleplasing, beëdigde verklarings en alle ander stukke vir die mosiehof op Donderdae moet voor 12-uur middag op die Vrydag wat die mosiedag onmiddellik voorafgaan of, indien daardie Vrydag 'n openbare vakansiedag is, op die hofdag wat bedoelde vakansiedag onmiddellik voorafgaan, by die griffier ingedien word.

- 7.3 Alle bestrede aansoeke moet gedurende die sittingstermyn elke Donderdag ter rolle geplaas word. Buite die sittingstermyne kan bestrede aansoeke as dringende aansoeke op Donderdae of op enige ander dag soos deur die regter-president aangewys, of in die diskresie van die voorsittende regter, aangehoor word.
- 7.4 Alle bestrede aansoeke moet geïndekseer, gepagineer en gebind wees ten tyde van plasing daarvan.
- 7.5 Alle ongeopponeerde aangeleenthede word geroep in die volgorde waarin hulle op die rol verskyn wat deur die griffier voorberei is, behoudens dat egskeidings eers geroep word nadat al die aansoeke afgehandel is; behoudens ook, dat senior advokate geregtig sal wees om al hul ongeopponeerde aansoeke en egskeidings in orde van senioriteit te roep voor alle ander regsverteenvoerders.
- 7.6 Indien 'n regsverteenvoerder in twee geopponeerde aansoeke verskyn op 'n mosiehofdag en indien daardie geopponeerde aansoeke nie deur dieselfde regter gehoor word nie, sal die aansoek wat deur die senior regter verhoor word eerste verhoor word, tensy sodanige senior regter 'n ander reëling getref het.
- 7.7 'n Regspraktisyn wat in die ongeopponeerde mosiehof verskyn sal ook geregtig wees om in geopponeerde reël 43 aansoeke te verskyn.
- 7.8 Geen regsverteenvoerder sal geregtig wees om op 'n mosiehofdag in sowel ongeopponeerde aansoeke (insluitende egskeidings) te verskyn en in geopponeerde aansoeke nie.
- 7.9 Geen regsverteenvoerder mag in meer as twee geopponeerde aansoeke verskyn nie en 'n regsverteenvoerder wat in twee geopponeerde aansoeke verskyn, sal nie geregtig wees om in 'n reël 43 aansoek te verskyn nie.
- 7.10 'n Regsverteenvoerder wat in slegs een geopponeerde aansoek verskyn, sal geregtig wees om in nie meer as drie reël 43 aansoeke te verskyn.
- 7.11 Waar 'n geopponeerde aansoek in terme van 'n ooreenkoms tussen die partye uitgestel sal word, of waar dit ongeopponeer geword het as gevolg van 'n skikking of ander rede, sal die volgende posisie geld:
- (a) Die regter wat die aansoek sou verhoor het, word onmiddellik deur die prokureurs van die partye van die ooreenkoms tussen die partye in kennis gestel, persoonlik of via die regter se sekretaris of sekretaresse.
 - (b) Die aansoek sal geroep word voor hierdie regter in die hof (voor ander geopponeerde aangeleenthede) om 9.30, tensy 'n bevel in kamers verleen word.
 - (c) Die regsverteenvoerders wat in die aangeleentheid sou verskyn het, en wat nie ander ongeopponeerde sake het nie, is

na die voormelde ooreenkoms nie meer onderworpe aan die bepalings in verband met geopponeerde sake soos hierbo uiteengesit nie.

- 7.12 Waar 'n prokureur 'n ongeopponeerde aansoek het wat van sodanige aard is dat hy verlang (omrede die belang of die omvang daarvan) dat dit deur 'n besondere advokaat hanteer word, versoek die prokureur die regter-president deur middel van 'n brief (wat afgelewer word saam met die kennisgewing van plasing) om die aangeleentheid in die hof vir geopponeerde aansoeke te plaas en dit word dan geag 'n geopponeerde aansoek te wees vir doeleindes van hierdie reël.
- 7.13 Waar 'n regsverteenwoordiger ingevolge hierdie reëls geregtig is om in twee howe te verskyn, moet sodanige regsverteenwoordiger verseker dat sy verskyning of opdragte nie die uitwerking het dat die verrigtinge in enige van die howe vertraag word as gevolg van sodanige verskyning of opdragte nie.
- 7.14 Waar die partye in 'n onbestrede egskeidingsaak 'n Akte van Dading aangegaan het, word normaalweg vereis dat die Gesinsadvokaat die reëling betreffende bewaring van minderjarige kinders oorweeg en goedkeur.

8. Verstekvonnisse

- 8.1 Waar uitwinbaarheidsverklaring of uitsetting versoek word, moet die praktyksnota uitgereik deur die Hoogste Hof van Appèl in **Standard Bank of SA Ltd v Sauderson and Others** 2006(2) SA 264 (HHA) te 277D-E nagekom word.
- 8.2 Waar skadevergoeding by verstek gevorder word, word mondelinge getuienis normaalweg vereis, maar die verhoorregter kan toelaat dat getuienis by wyse van beëdigde verklaring voorgelê word indien die omstandighede dit regverdig.

9. Sekwestrasies

- 9.1 Alle kontantbedrae wat deur, of ten behoeve van, of namens, die respondent betaal word by 'n aansoek om verpligte sekwestrasie of deur 'n applikant by 'n aansoek om vrywillige boedeloorgawe moet by die Voogdyfonds inbetaal word en die Meestersverslag moet vermeld dat dit inderdaad gedoen is.
- 9.2 Geen aansoek vir 'n finale sekwestrasiebevel sal verhoor word nie tensy die Meester se verslag wat spesifiek t.o.v. sodanige aansoek verkry moet word, vooraf voor die Hof geplaas word.

Nota: Die Meester dring daarop aan dat die bepalings van artikel 19(1) van die Insolvensiewet m.b.t. 'n inventaris behoorlik nagekom word deur Balju's, en moet sodanige inventaris derhalwe so spoedig moontlik aan die Meester verskaf word. Die Meester sal nie 'n verslag uitreik nie alvorens bedoelde inventaris vooraf aan hom verskaf was nie. Indien die afwesigheid van bedoelde inventaris tot gevolg het dat die bevel *nisi* nie bekragtig word nie, sal 'n verduideliking vir die

afwesigheid verskaf moet word en kan 'n gepaste kostebevel oorweeg word.

- 9.3 Elke bevel *nisi* in verpligte sekwestrasie-aansoeke sal na vier (4) weke keerbaar wees, tensy die Hof anders gelas.
- 9.4.1 Aansoeke vir voorlopige sekwestrasie en vrywillige boedeloorgawe word deur hierdie Hof benader op die grondslag dat die koste van sekwestrasie en administrasie R20 000,00 sal beloop. (Hierdie bedrag mag van tyd tot tyd aangepas word.)
- 9.4.2 Indien 'n aansoekdoener van mening is dat daardie koste in 'n besondere geval minder sal wees, dan moet 'n beraming daarvan aan die aansoekstukke geheg word en daardie beraming moet voor die Meester gelê word, wat kommentaar daarop aan die Hof moet lewer.
- 9.5 In aansoeke vir rehabilitasie moet alle kurators 'n verslag by die Meester sowel as by die Hof indien, al het hulle niks om onder die Meester of die Hof se aandag te bring nie. Met ander woorde, selfs as hulle niks het om oor verslag te doen nie, dan moet hulle daardie feit onder die Meester en die Hof se aandag bring.

10. Eksepsies en Tussenpleitgedinge

Eksepsies en tussenpleitgedinge word geplaas vir verhoor op 'n Vrydag. Betogshoofde in tussenpleitgedinge moet beteken word nie later nie as 15h00 op die Dinsdag onmiddellik voorafgaande die dag van verhoor en ooreenkomstig Reël 13(4) ten aansien van eksepsies.

11. Reël 43 aansoeke

- 11.1 Reël 43 aansoeke word vir verhoor geplaas om 9.30 en word normaalweg vanaf 14h15 gehoor.
- 11.2 Beide partye en hulle prokureurs moet by die Hof teenwoordig wees op die oggend van die verhoor en poog om die geskille tussen die partye by te lê en, indien moontlik, om die egskedingsgeding te skik, in welke geval die Hof voor wie die reël 43 aansoek geplaas was, die egskedingsgeding sal aanhoor.
- 11.3 Indien die aangeleentheid nie teen 14h15 geskik is nie, sal die reël 43 aansoek sonder verwyl gargumenteer word.
- 11.4 Die regter wat voorsit by die reël 43 aansoek kan toestem dat die aangeleentheid voor 14h15 gehoor word indien beide regsverteenwoordigers beskikbaar is en geen ander hof daardeur verontrief word nie.

12. Appèlle en Hersienings

- 12.1 Gedurende sittingsstermyne word elke Maandag vir die verhoor van appèl- en hersieningsake voorbehou: Met dien verstande dat strafappèl- en hersieningsake ook in opdrag van die regter-president vir verhoor gedurende vakansietyd op die rol geplaas kan word.

12.2 Hersienings word gewoonlik deur twee regters aangehoor.

13. Betoogshoofde

13.1 Strafappèlle vanaf landdroshof

Ingevolge die bepalings van reël 51(4) van die Eenvormige Hofreëls word die volgende tydperke bepaal waarbinne betoogshoofde in alle strafappèlle vanaf die landdroshof afgelewer moet word nl.:

- (a) Deur die appellant minstens 15 hofdae voor die verhoor van die appèl; en
- (b) Deur die respondent minstens 10 hofdae voor die verhoor van die appèl.

13.2 Siviele appèlle vanaf landdroshof

Eenvormige reël 50(9) geld [15 en 10 dae onderskeidelik].

13.3 Geopponeerde aansoeke

Betoogshoofde in alle geopponeerde aansoeke buiten reël 43 aansoeke, moet by die griffier geliasseer word nie later nie as 15h00 op die Dinsdag wat die betrokke mosiehofdag onmiddellik voorafgaan, of indien sodanige Dinsdag 'n openbare vakansiedag is, op die hofdag wat sodanige vakansiedag onmiddelik voorafgaan.

13.4 Hersienings ingevolge Hofreël 53 en Eksepsies

Met betrekking tot alle hersienings ingevolge die bepalings van reël 53 van die Eenvormige Hofreëls en met betrekking tot alle eksepsies moet betoogshoofde by die griffier geliasseer word –

- (a) Deur die applikant/ekspiënt minstens 15 hofdae voor die datum van verhoor; en
- (b) Deur die respondent minstens 10 hofdae voor die datum van verhoor.

14. Skrapping van die Rol

14.1 Indien 'n aangeleentheid van die rol geskrap word omdat daar geen verskyning is nie, word dit beskou as finaal afgehandel en kan dit her-

ingestel word op die rol op voorlegging van 'n verduideliking onder eed met betrekking tot waarom daar geen verskyning was nie.

- 14.2 Wanneer 'n appèl van die rol geskrap is, stuur die griffier die oorkonde van die verrigtinge terug na die klerk van die hof.
- 14.3.1 In alle strafappèlle waarin die appellant se betoogshoofde nie ingehandig was op die datum waarop die *dies* vir die inhandiging daarvan verstryk het nie, staan dit die Staat vry om aansoek te doen vir skrapping van die appèl weens bedoelde versuim deur die appellant.

- 14.3.3 Waar die Staat aansoek gedoen het vir skrapping van die appèl, maar waar daarna 'n aansoek vir kondonasië van die appellant se versuim ingehandig word en/of waar daar deur appellant betoogshoofde ingehandig word, moet die Staat ook betoogshoofde inhandig, al was die appellant se betoogshoofde nie betyds ingehandig nie.
- 14.3.4 Waar die Staat aansoek gedoen het vir skrapping van die appèl en waar daar geen kondonasië-aansoek en/of betoogshoofde deur die appellant ingehandig was nie, hoef die Staat geen betoogshoofde in te handig nie tensy die betrokke voorsittende regter die staat versoek om dit te doen.

15. Borgappèlle

- 15.1 Alle borgappèlle is dringend en word so spoedig moontlik afgehandel.
- 15.2 Borgappèlle word by ontvangs deur die griffier voor die diensregter geplaas, wat dit afhandel deur
- (a) dit self te verhoor; of
 - (b) na konsultasie met die regter-president, dit so gou as moontlik op die rol te plaas vir verhoor.
- 15.3 Die diensregter bepaal of betoogshoofde ingehandig moet word, en indien wel, wanneer.

16. Aansoeke om verlof om te appelleer vanaf die Hooggeregshof in siviele aangeleenthede

- 16.1 Dit is die plig van die applikant om verlof om te appelleer om 'n afskrif van die uitspraak waarteen ge-appelleer word te bekom en om alle nodige stappe te neem om die aansoek verder te voer tot voleinding.
- 16.2 Die uitspraak moet deur die applikant by die griffier geliasseer word binne een maand nadat die aansoek geliasseer is.
- 16.3 Sodra die aansoek by die griffier geliasseer is, moet die griffier binne een week geskikte datums by die betrokke regter aanvra en daarna 'n datum reël wat geskik is vir alle partye en die aangeleentheid vir

verhoor plaas en moet die saak dienooreenkomstig deur applikant ter rolle geplaas word.

16.4 Aansoeke om verlof om te appelleer word geplaas vir verhoor om 9 vm. op 'n Vrydag of op enige ander dag en tyd wat die regter bepaal.

17. Aansoeke om verlof om te appelleer vanaf die Hooggeregshof in strafsake

17.1 Waar die griffier 'n aansoek om verlof om te appelleer ontvang binne die tyd toegelaat ingevolge artikel 316(1)(b) van die Strafproseswet 51 van 1977 (14 gewone dae na die oplegging van vonnis) volg die normale prosedure.

17.2 Waar 'n appellant in persoon 'n aansoek om verlof om te appelleer liasseer, stuur die griffier die aansoek na die Regshulpraad wat dan, na aanvraag van 'n datum, die saak in oorleg met die DOV ter rolle plaas.

17.3 Aansoeke om verlof om te appelleer sal geplaas word vir verhoor om 9 vm. op 'n Vrydag of op enige ander dag en tyd wat die regter bepaal.

18. Kleding van praktisyns in die Hooggeregshof

Wanneer regspraktisyns in die Hooggeregshof verskyn, moet hulle ooreenkomstig die volgende riglyne geklee wees:

A Advokate

By virtue of the powers vested in me under Section 15(3) of the National Forests Act, 1998, I, Lindiwe Benedicta Hendricks hereby publish a list of all protected trees belonging to a particular species under section 12(1)(d) set out in the Schedule below.

The effect of this declaration is that in terms of section 15(1) of the National Forests Act, 1998, no person may cut, disturb, damage or destroy any protected tree or possess, collect, remove, transport, export, purchase, sell, donate or in any other manner acquire or dispose of any protected tree or any forest product derived from a protected tree, except under a licence granted by the Minister to an applicant and subject to such period and conditions as may be stipulated.

Contravention of this declaration is regarded as a first category offence that may result in a person who is found guilty of being sentenced to a fine or imprisonment for a period up to three years, or to both a fine and imprisonment.

1. SCHEDULE

- (a) **"the Act"** means the Natural Scientific Professions Act, 2003 (Act 27 of 2003).
- (b) **"the year"** means the period commencing on 1 April of any year and ending on 31 March of the next year.
- (c) **"application fee"** means the fee payable when an appeal is lodged against any Council decision.
- (d) **"annual fee"** means the fee payable by the registered member within 60 days from the date on which he/she is informed (in writing) that his/her annual fee has become payable;
- (e) **"registration fee"** means the fee payable when a person applies for registration in terms of Section 20(2)(b) of the Act.
- (f) **"penalty fee"** means the fee payable in terms of Section 23(3)(d) of the Act when a person applies for reinstating his/her registration.

2. FEES

- (b) **Registration fees:**
(i) Professional Natural Scientist : **R620,00 (VAT inclusive).**
(ii) Candidate Natural Scientist : **R340,00 (VAT inclusive).**

(iv) Upgrading of registration status : **R620,00 (VAT inclusive).**
- (c) **Annual fees:**
(i) Professional Natural Scientist : **R540,00 (VAT inclusive).**
(ii) Candidate Natural Scientist : **R220,00 (VAT inclusive).**
(iii) Certificate Natural Scientist : **R360,00 (VAT inclusive).**
(iv) Pensioner (all levels of registration) : **R130,00 (VAT inclusive).**
- (d) **Penalty fees:**
(i) Professional Natural Scientist : **R1 860,00 (VAT inclusive).**
(ii) Candidate Natural Scientist : **R1 020,00 (VAT inclusive).**
(iii) Certificate Natural Scientist : **R1 200,00 (VAT inclusive).**

3. NOTES:

- (a) A registration fee is payable for each field of practice for which registration is requested.
- (b) Registration fees are not refundable, should an application not be successful.
- (c) A person whose registration was cancelled in terms of Section 21(1)(a)(iii) of the Act will have to pay three times the registration fee for each category.
- (d) New registrations and upgrading of status: Annual fees will become payable on the 1st of April of the year following the year of registration, provided that if a person is registered during the first three months of a year, the annual fees will become payable on the 1st of April of the same year.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In this Schedule, reference to the “**Rules**” means the rules relating to continuing education and training for registered health practitioners published as Board Notice No. 29 of 2007, and any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Rules shall have that meaning.

2. **Amendment of Rule 4 of the rules**
 - 2.1 Rule 4 of the Rules is hereby amended by the substitution for sub-rule (1) of the following sub-rule:-

“(1) a practitioner must accumulate at least 30 continuing education units, of which at least five must be on human rights, ethics and medical law, within every year.”
