NOTICE 1367 OF 2009



INDEPENDENT COMMUNICATIONS AUTHORITY OF SOUTH AFRICA

1. On the 9th of November 2007, the Independent Communications Authority of South Africa (the "Authority") published a Findings Document on the market for Call Termination in South Africa (Government Gazette No. 30449).
2. The Findings document also states that "No pronouncement is made on the effectiveness of competition in this market" (Government Gazette No. 30449, page 9).
3. The Authority, pursuant to Section 4(3)(g) of the Independent Communications Authority Act regulations entitled Standard Terms and Conditions for Individual/Class Licences (Government Gazette No. 30530 and 30512 respectively) informs all firms with an Electronic Communications Network Services and/or Electronic Communications Services Licence of the release of a questionnaire seeking information with the following objective, amongst others:

- To evaluate the effectiveness of competition in the Call Termination market in South Africa.
4. All Licensees are required to submit their responses to the questionnaire by **20 November 2009**.
