GENERAL NOTICE –ERRATUM: FINAL TERRESTRIAL BROADCASTING FREQUENCY PLAN

- (1) On 18 November 2009, the Authority published a Notice (No. 1538) in Government Gazette no. 32728, containing the Final Terrestrial Broadcasting Frequency Plan 2008 in accordance with section 34 of the Electronic Communication Act (36 of 2005, "the Act").
- (2) The Authority hereby wishes to correct an error on page 7 of the Notice referred to above in the following manner:
 - a. Deletion of the word [draft] as it appears before the words "Terrestrial Broadcasting Frequency Plan" on page 7, first line of the first paragraph. The wording should thus be " Final Terrestrial Broadcasting Frequency plan".
 - b. Additional Spare FM Frequencies

The FM frequencies depicted on schedule B below are additional frequencies for FM sound broadcasting which are part of Annexure A in the Final Terrestrial Broadcasting Frequency plan 2008.
