## **Explanatory Memorandum to the Provincial Allocations set out in Schedule 4**

This *Gazette* is published in terms of the 2009 Division of Revenue Act (Act No. 12 of 2009) and provides information on additional allocations and adjustments to existing allocations to provinces in the 2009/10 financial year.

This is necessitated by the need to stop the flow of funds in terms of section 28 of the 2009 Division of Revenue Act (Act No. 12 of 2009) and the need to re-allocate funds to provinces, as approved in terms of section 29 of the 2009 Division of Revenue Act (Act No. 12 of 2009).

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was originally in the 2009 Division of Revenue Act (Act No. 12 of 2009) as published in *Government Gazette* No. 32106 of 03 April 2009.

This notice affects the Public Transport Operations Grant:

- a) In compliance with section 28 of the 2009 Division of Revenue Act (Act No. 12 of 2009), the national Department of Transport stops the transfer of funds to the value of R60 million from Schedule 4, following slow spending on the part of the KwaZulu-Natal (R60 million).
  - b) In compliance with section 29 of the 2009 Division of Revenue Act (Act No. 12 of 2009), the national Department of Transport re-allocates funds to North West to the value of R60 million from Schedule 4, following demonstrated capacity to spend in North West.
