Effective date of the National Register of Gambling Devices and Machines

I, Dr Rob Davies, Minister of Trade and Industry, acting in terms of section 87 of the National Gambling Act, 2004 (Act No. 7 of 2004), in consultation with the National Gambling Board, hereby regulate as follows, in matters pertaining to the National Register for Gambling Devices and Machines by the National Gambling Board -

I proclaim **7 June 2010** to be the date on which the national register of gambling devices and machines is implemented as contemplated in section 65 (c) (iii), read with section 19, 21 and 23 of the National Gambling Act No 7 of 2004 and Regulations 8 to 12 of the National Gambling Regulations 2004 promulgated by Government Notice No. 26994 of 12 November 2007, to start operating

All manufacturers and importers must ensure connectivity and compatibility of their systems to the register so as to enable them to upload data. Further, all data must be verified for accuracy and completeness on sign off.

All information contemplated in the register of gambling devices and machine must be uploaded on the system by **6 August 2010**, with regular updates uploaded quarterly thereafter.
