ELECTORAL COMMISSION ACT 51 OF 1996

AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATIONS FOR THE REGISTRATION OF POLITICAL PARTIES (2004)

The Electoral Commission has, in terms of section 23 of the Electoral Commission Act, 1996 (Act No. 51 of 1996), made the regulations set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In this Schedule, unless the context indicates otherwise-
 “the Act” means the Electoral Commission Act, 1996 (Act No. 51 of 1996); and
 “the Regulations” means the Regulations for the Registration of Political Parties, 2004 published under Government Notice No. R. 13 of 07 January 2004.

Amendment of Regulation 2 of the Regulations

2. Regulation 2 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of subregulation (3).

Amendment of Regulation 3 of the Regulations

3. Regulation 3 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (b) of subregulation (1) of the following paragraph:

“(b) The deed of foundation referred to in section 15A of the Act must be signed by 100 registered voters, whose full names and identity numbers must be reflected against their signatures.”.
