**THE SOUTH AFRICAN SCHOOLS ACT, 1996 (ACT NO. 84 OF 1996)****APPROVAL FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE SENIOR CERTIFICATE  
EXAMINATION UNTIL MAY/JUNE 2014**

I, Angelina Matsie Motshekga, Minister of Basic Education, after consultation with the Council of Education Ministers and in terms of *section 6(A)* of the *South African Schools Act, 1996 (Act. No. 84 of 1996)*, hereby grant approval for the extension of the Senior Certificate examination until May/June 2014.

The extended Senior Certificate examinations from May/June 2012 until May/June will be based on a reduced number of examination question papers prepared, as set out in **Schedule 1**.

No candidate for the extended Senior Certificate examinations during the period May/June 2012 until May/June 2014 will be disadvantaged if he or she has already selected approved subjects not listed in **Schedule 1**, or who has failed such a subject at a previous May/June Senior Certificate examination. In such cases special arrangements will be made with the relevant Provincial Departments of Education where these candidates are registered for the May/June 2012, 2013 and 2014 Senior Certificate examinations, provided that such Provincial Department of Education has been informed not later than 30 September of the year prior to the May/June examination. The registration requirements for the extended Senior Certificate examinations during the period May/June 2012 until May/June 2014 are set out in **Schedule 2**.

## SCHEDULE 2

The following two categories of candidates may register for the extended Senior Certificate examination commencing in May/June 2012:

### **Category 1:**

- (a) Unsuccessful candidates in the Senior Certificate examination of 2007;
- (b) Part-time candidates who had already enrolled for the Senior Certificate,
- (c) Candidates who have passed Grade 11 in previous years; and
- (d) Other special cases where the Heads of provincial and independent assessment bodies may use their discretionary powers to allow such candidates admission to the May/June Senior Certificate examination.

### **Category 2:**

Adult candidates who are 21 years or older and who have not registered for the Senior Certificate examination before, provided they meet the following requirements:

- (a) Must undertake to complete the Senior Certificate in the next two to three years;
  - (b) May register for 2012 only;
  - (c) Must be 21 years and older;
  - (d) Must provide a motivation to the Head of Department, why they should be allowed to register; and
  - (e) Approval must be granted by the Head of Department.
