**ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS ACT, 2005 (ACT NO. 36 OF 2005)**

**REASONS FOR DECISION: AMENDMENT OF BROADCASTING SERVICE LICENCES  
FOR PURPOSES OF DIGITAL TERRESTRIAL TELEVISION**
