PROPOSED GUIDELINE SCOPE OF SERVICES AND TARIFF OF FEES: 2012

Invitation to the public to comment on the Proposed Guideline Scope of Services and Tariff of Fees for 2012

1. Background

The Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA) is required to, on an annual basis, determine guideline professional fees and publish same in the Government Gazette. ECSA has established a Fees Committee, comprising representatives of Service Provider Organizations and of clients in the private and the public sectors, to recommend annual updates of the Guideline Scope of Services and Tariff of Fees for professional engineering services. The Guideline, recommended for publication before 1 January 2012, is now available for Consideration of Council.

2. Call for Comment

The determination of the Guideline Scope of Services and Tariff of Fees must be done after consultation with Voluntary Associations, representatives of service providers and of clients in the public and private sectors in terms of section 34(2) of the Engineering Professions Act, Act 46 of 2000. An invitation is made to Voluntary Associations and to any member of the public to submit comments on the recommended Guidelines by **19 October 2011**.
