PART B: MINIMUM WAGES

- 1. Substitute clause 2(1) as reflected in Government Notice R 141 of 13 February 2009 which reads 'With effect from 1 March 2009 an employer must pay a farm worker at least the minimum wage prescribed in clause 3' with:
 - 'With effect from 1 March 2012 an employer must pay a farm worker at least the minimum wage prescribed in clause 3'
- 2. Substitute clause 3 with the following:

3. MINIMUM WAGES FOR FARM WORKERS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE

(1) An employer must pay a farm worker who is 15 years of age or older, but not less than 18 years and who works for 35 hours per week or less at least the hourly rate, specified in Table 1
