During the State of the Nation Address, the President announced a number of heritage projects to be implemented, including the proposed renaming of the three State residences. They are as follows:

- Kings House Residence in Durban to be renamed after *Dr John Langalibalele Dube*;
- Presidential Guest House in Pretoria to be renamed after *Sefako Mapogo Makgatho*; and
- The Diplomatic Guest House in Waterkloof to be renamed *Johnny Makatini*.

The proposed renaming will be implemented in terms of the South African Geographical Names Council Act of 1998 (Act No. 118 of 1998) and therefore the South African public is asked to forward their inputs and comments on these proposals to the Department of Public Works before the 30 March 2012.
