**FOODSTUFFS, COSMETICS AND DISINFECTANTS ACT, 1972  
(ACT 54 OF 1972)****REGULATIONS GOVERNING IRRADIATED FOODSTUFFS: DRAFT AMENDMENT**

The Minister of Health intends, in terms of section 15 (1) of the Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants Act, 1972 (Act 54 of 1972) to make the regulations in the Schedule.

Interested persons are invited to submit any substantiated comments or representations on the proposed draft amendments to the regulations, to the Director – General of Health, Private Bag X828, Pretoria, 0001 (for the attention of the Director: Food Control), within three (3) months of the date of publication of this notice.


**SCHEDULE**

1. In these regulations “the Regulations” means the regulations published under Government Notice No. R. 1600 of 22 July 1983.

**Amendment of Regulation 2**

2. Regulation 2 is hereby amended by inserting the following sub-paragraph:

(b) Approvals referred to in sub-regulation 2(a), shall be in line with the *Guidelines for Monitoring Irradiated Foodstuffs in South Africa*, which is available from the Directorate: Food Control, or on the website of the Department of Health at: [www.doh.gov.za](http://www.doh.gov.za).
