APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT OF INDIVIDUAL COMMERCIAL SOUND BROADCASTING SERVICE LICENCE AND RADIO FREQUENCY SPECTRUM LICENCE BY iGagasi99.5 FM

- 1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice that it has received an application from iGagasi99.5 FM, for an amendment of its Individual Commercial Sound Broadcasting Service (CSBS) Licence and its Radio Frequency Spectrum (RFS) Licence lodged in terms of regulation 9 of the Processes and Procedures Regulations for Individual Licences and Special Temporary Authorisations of 2010 read with sections 10(a) (b) (c) (d) (f) (g) and (h) of the Electronic Communications Act, No 36 of 2005.
- 2. IGagasi99.5 FM seeks the approval from the Authority to amend its RFS Licence and clause 2 of its CSBS Licence to include Glencoe to be part of its coverage area. The specifications of proposed technical amendments are set out in the table below.
- 3. The application, relevant schedule and any representations received pursuant thereto would be made available and be open for inspection by interested parties in the Authority's library during the Authority's normal office hours.
- 4. Interested parties are invited to lodge written representations in relation to the application within twenty one (21) days of the date of publication of this notice. Interested parties must indicate in their written representations if they would like to be afforded an opportunity to make an oral presentation in the event that the Authority decides to conduct the public hearings on this matter.

- 5. IGagasi99.5 FM shall be entitled to respond in writing to written representations made by interested persons on the amendment application, and such written response must be lodged with the Authority within forty two (42) days of the date of publication of this notice in the *Government Gazette*. IGagasi99.5 FM must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of such response by hand, or has sent a copy of such response by registered mail or by facsimile to the relevant person having made such written representations.
