ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS ACT, 2005 (ACT NO. 36 OF 2005)
RE-CATEGORIZATION OF 91.3 MHz IN THE TYGERBERG AREA IN WESTERN CAPE
PROVINCE

1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice of its intention to re-categorise channel 91.3 MHz in the Tygerberg area in Western Cape province for provision community sound broadcasting in terms of section 30 the Electronic Communications Act 36 of 2005 ("the ECA").
2. The purpose of this re-categorisation is to migrate Voice of the Cape FM from channel 100.4 MHz to 91.3 MHz. VOC FM currently broadcasts 24hrs on every alternating day on a sharing basis with Radio 786.
3. Interested persons are invited to lodge written representations in relation to the application within 21 days from the date of the publication. Interested parties must indicate in their written representations if they would like to be afforded an opportunity to make an oral representation in the event that the Authority decides to conduct the public hearings on this matter.
4. The submissions and any representations received pursuant thereto would be made available and be open for inspection by interested parties in the Authority's library during the Authority's normal office hours.

5. All written representations, response and other correspondences in respect of the Radio Frequency Spectrum Licence must be directed to Mr Monde Mbanga at the Engineering and Technology Division, at Block A, **OR** by fax no. (011) 566 3166 **OR** by e-mail: mmbanga@icasa.org.za
6. Persons who lodge representations in terms hereof, shall at the time of lodgement furnish proof to the satisfaction of the Authority that a copy of the representation has been delivered by hand to Mr. Imam Alli at 2 Queenspark Avenue, Salt River, 7925, Western Cape **OR** sent by registered post to, P. O. Box 16210, Vlaeberg, 8018 **OR** by fax to (021) 447 7271.
7. Radio Voice of the Cape shall be entitled to respond in writing to written representations made by interested persons on the amendment application, and such written response must be lodged with the Authority within forty two (42) days of the date of publication of this notice in the *Government Gazette*.
8. Radio Voice of the Cape must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of such response by hand, or has sent a copy of such response by registered mail or by facsimile to the relevant person having made such written representations.
