





DIAMOND EXPORT LEVY (ADMINISTRATION) ACT, 2007 (ACT NO. 14 OF 2007)
AMENDMENT OF RULES (DAR/130)

Under section 18 of the Diamond Export Levy (Administration) Act, 2007 (Act No. 14 of 2007), the rules published in Government Notice R.1169 of 31 October 2008 are hereby amended to the extent set out in the Schedule hereto. The deletion in Schedule A of rule 14.02 is deemed to have come into operation on 30 September 2009.

I, Ebrahim Mohamed, commissioner of the National Consumer Commission (NCC), do hereby advise that the NCC, in line with the provisions of section 11 (3) of the Consumer Protection Act 68 of 2008 (CPA), read with regulation 4 of the Consumer Protection Act Regulations (Regulation), intends recognising as authoritative, a registry in which any person may register a pre-emptive block, either generally or for specific purposes, against any communication that is primarily for the purpose of direct marketing.
