ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS ACT, 2005 (ACT NO. 36 OF 2005)

SUBMISSION OF LATE APPLICATIONS FOR RENEWALS AFTER EXPIRATION OF THE LICENCES BY CLASS SOUND BROADCASTING SERVICE LICENSEES

- 1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice to all Class Sound Community Broadcasting Service Licensees who have failed to submit their renewal applications to do so within thirty (30) working days from the publication of this notice in the Government *Gazette*.
- 2. In terms of Regulation 4(1) of the Standard Terms and Conditions for Class Broadcasting Services Regulations of 2010, a Class Community Sound Broadcasting Service Licence is valid for five (5) years. Regulation 9(2) of the Class Licensing Processes and Procedures Regulations of 2010 provides that a notice to renew a licence must be submitted to the Authority no earlier than twelve (12) months and no later than six (6) months before the expiry of the licence. The Authority has noted that there are several Class Sound Community Broadcasting Service Licensees who did not submit their renewal applications.
- 3. The renewal applications must be made in term of regulation 9 read with regulation 5 of the Class Licensing Processes and Procedures Regulations of 2010 using Form F and must be accompanied by the applicable fee.
- 4. Failure to submit renewal applications within the above stipulated timeline will result in the Authority closing the affected broadcasting licensee.

- 5. Attached is the schedule containing a list of broadcasters that have not submitted the renewal applications to the Authority.
- 6. All renewal applications must be made for the attention of General Manager: Licensing and Compliance and submitted at Block D, Pinmill Farm, 164 Katherine Street, Sandton, Johannesburg, or Private Bag x 10002, Sandton, 2146.
