The Tourism Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (Tourism B-BBEE) Charter Council hereby invites all interested and affected persons and organisations to participate in the development of the Tourism B-BBEE Codes to align them to the Amended Generic Codes of Good Practice.

Following the issuing of the Generic Codes of Good Practice, under section 9 (1) of the B-BBEE Act No. 53 of 2003, by the Minister of Trade and Industry (the dti) on 11 October 2013, all Sector Charter Councils are required to align their sector-specific Codes to the dti's new B-BBEE Generic Codes of Good Practice. A transitional period of eighteen (18) months, from 11 October 2013 to 30 April 2015, has been allocated for this process.

The Tourism B-BBEE Charter Council has initiated the process of developing a draft Tourism B-BBEE Sector Code. The Council will conduct two (2) consultations per province in the months of August and September 2014.
