## SCHEDULE

### 1. Definitions

In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise indicates, a word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the ICASA Act, has the meaning so assigned:

**"ICASA Act"** means the Independent Communications Authority of South Africa Act, 2000 (Act No. 13 of 2000) as amended.

**"Prescribed form"** means a notice in terms in terms of section 4C (2) (a) and (b) of the ICASA Act.

### 2. Purpose

The purpose of these Regulations is to prescribe a form whereby the Authority, during the conduct of an inquiry in terms of section 4B of the ICASA Act, may:

- (a) require any person to provide such particulars and information as may be reasonably required by it; and
- (b) require any person to appear before it at the date, time and place specified in the notice.

### 3. Prescribed Form

The notice in terms of section 4C (2) (a) and (b) of the ICASA Act shall be in the format as laid out in the Annexure.

#### **4. Commencement**

These Regulations are called the Inquiry Prescribed Form Regulations 2014 and shall come into operation upon publication in the Government gazette.
