APPLICATIONS FOR A TRANSFER OF INDIVIDUAL ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE AND INDIVIDUAL ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK SERVICE LICENCES FROM UMOYA NETWORK SOLUTIONS (PTY) LTD TO REFLEX COMMUNICATIONS (PTY) LTD

1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice that it has received applications from Umoya Network Solutions (Pty) Ltd for a transfer of its Individual Electronic Communications Service (I-ECS) and Individual Electronic Communications Network Service (I-ECNS) licences. The applications were lodged in terms of regulation 11 of the Processes and Procedures Regulations for Individual Licences and Special Temporary Authorisations of 2010 read with sections 13(1), (2) and (6) of the Electronic Communications Act, as amended.
2. The transfer applications seek the approval from the Authority to transfer the I-ECS and I-ECNS licences from Umoya Network Solutions (Pty) Ltd to Reflex Communications (Pty) Ltd.
3. The applications, relevant schedule and any representations received pursuant thereto would be made available and open for inspection by interested parties in the Authority's library during the Authority's normal office hours.
4. Interested parties are invited to lodge written representations in relation to the applications within twenty one (21) working days from the date of publication of this notice in the Government Gazette.

5. Persons who make such representations must indicate in their written representations whether they require an opportunity to make oral representations in the event the Authority decides to hold public hearings.

Umoya Network Solutions (Pty) Ltd shall be entitled to respond in writing to written representations made by interested persons on the transfer applications, and such written response must be lodged with the Authority within forty-two (42) working days from the date of publication of this notice in the Government Gazette. Umoya Network Solutions (Pty) Ltd must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of such response by hand, **OR** has sent a copy of such response by registered mail **OR** by facsimile **OR** by e-mail to the relevant person having made such written representations.
