# PROCLAMATION

*by the*

*President of the Republic of South Africa*

No. R. 16, 2015

## **SPECIAL INVESTIGATING UNITS AND SPECIAL TRIBUNALS ACT, 1996 (ACT NO. 74 OF 1996): AMENDMENT OF PROCLAMATION NO. R. 49 OF 2014**

Under section 2(4) of the Special Investigating Units and Special Tribunals Act, 1996 (Act No. 74 of 1996), I hereby amend Proclamation No. R. 49 of 2014, by—

(a) the substitution for the first paragraph of the Proclamation of the following paragraph:

“WHEREAS allegations as contemplated in section 2(2) of the Special Investigating Units and Special Tribunals Act, 1996 (Act No. 74 of 1996) (hereinafter referred to as the “Act”), have been made in respect of the affairs of—

(a) the KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Treasury (hereinafter referred to as “the Treasury”);

(b) the departments of the KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Government as set out in Schedule 2 to the Public Service Act, 1994 (Proclamation No. 103 of 1994), which received funding from the Treasury in respect of the ‘Commemorating Prisoners of War – St Helena’ event and the Durban International North Sea Jazz Festival (hereinafter referred to as ‘the Departments’); and

(c) the KwaZulu-Natal Sharks Board.”;

(b) the insertion in the second and fourth paragraphs of the Proclamation after the expression “Treasury”, wherever it appears, of the expression “, the Departments and the KwaZulu-Natal Sharks Board”;

(c) the substitution for paragraph 2 of the Schedule to the Proclamation of the following paragraph:

“2. The validity of funding provided by the Treasury in respect of the—

(a) ‘Commemorating Prisoners of War – St Helena’ event;

(b) Durban International North Sea Jazz Festival; and

(c) KwaZulu-Natal Sharks Board,

and any unauthorised, irregular or fruitless and wasteful expenditure incurred by the Treasury in respect of the provision of such funding.”; and

(d) the addition of the following paragraph to the Schedule of the Proclamation:

“3. Any unauthorised, irregular or fruitless and wasteful expenditure incurred by the Departments and the KwaZulu-Natal Sharks Board in respect of the funding received from the Treasury contemplated in paragraph 2.”.

### **WET OP SPESIALE ONDERSOEKEENHEDE EN SPESIALE TRIBUNALE, 1996 (WET No. 74 VAN 1996): WYSIGING VAN PROKLAMASIE NO. R. 49 VAN 2014**

Kragtens artikel 2(4) van die Wet op Spesiale Ondersoekeenhede en Spesiale Tribunale, 1996 (Wet No. 74 van 1996), wysig ek hierby Proklamasie No. R. 49 van 2014, deur—

- (a) die eerste paragraaf van die Proklamasie deur die volgende paragraaf te vervang:
- “AANGESIEN bewerings soos beoog in artikel 2(2) van die Wet op Spesiale Ondersoekeenhede en Spesiale Tribunale, 1996 (Wet No. 74 van 1996) (hierna na verwys as die "Wet"), gemaak is in verband met die aangeleentheid van—
- (a) die KwaZulu-Natal Provinsiale Tesourie (hierna na verwys as "die Tesourie");
- (b) die departemente van die KwaZulu-Natalse Provinsiale Regering soos uiteengesit in Bylae 2 tot die Staatsdienswet, 1994 (Proklamasie No. 103 van 1994), wat befondsing ontvang het van die Tesourie ten opsigte van die 'Commemorating Prisoners of War – St Helena' gebeurlikheid en die 'Durban International North Sea Jazz Festival' (hierna na verwys as 'die Departemente'); en
- (c) die KwaZulu-Natalse Haaibestrydingsraad”.
- (b) die invoeging in die tweede en vierde paragraawe van die Proklamasie van die uitdrukking “, die Departemente en die KwaZulu-Natalse Haaibestrydingsraad” na die uitdrukking “Tesourie”, waar dit ook al voorkom;

- (c) die vervanging van paragraaf 2 van die Bylae tot die Proklamasie deur die volgende paragraaf:
- “2. Die geldigheid van befondsing verskaf deur die Tesourie ten opsigte van die—
- (a) 'Commemorating Prisoners of War – St Helena' gebeurlikheid;
  - (b) 'Durban International North Sea Jazz Festival'; en
  - (c) KwaZulu-Natalse Haaibestrydingsraad, en enige ongemagtigde, onreëlmatige of vrugtelose en verspilde uitgawes deur die Tesourie aangegaan ten opsigte van die verskaffing van sodanige befondsing.”; en
- (d) die byvoeging van die volgende paragraaf tot die Bylae van die Proklamasie:
- “3. Enige ongemagtigde, onreëlmatige of vrugtelose en verspilde uitgawes deur die Departemente en die KwaZulu-Natalse Haaibestrydingsraad aangegaan ten opsigte van die befondsing ontvang van die Tesourie soos bedoel in paragraaf 2.”.
