


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IMPORTANT Information from Government Printing Works

Dear Valued Customers,

Government Printing Works has implemented rules for completing and submitting the electronic Adobe Forms when you, the customer, submits your notice request.

Please take note of these guidelines when completing your form.

GPW Business Rules

1. No hand written notices will be accepted for processing, this includes Adobe forms which have been completed by hand.



- Notices can only be submitted in Adobe electronic form format to the email submission address <u>submit.egazette@gpw.gov.za</u>. This means that any notice submissions not on an Adobe electronic form that are submitted to this mailbox will be <u>rejected</u>. National or Provincial gazette notices, where the Z95 or Z95Prov must be an Adobe form but the notice content (body) will be an attachment.
- 3. Notices brought into GPW by "walk-in" customers on electronic media can only be submitted in Adobe electronic form format. This means that any notice submissions not on an Adobe electronic form that are submitted by the customer on electronic media will be <u>rejected</u>. National or Provincial gazette notices, where the Z95 or Z95Prov must be an Adobe form but the notice content (body) will be an attachment.
- 4. All customers who walk in to GPW that wish to submit a notice that is not on an electronic Adobe form will be routed to the Contact Centre where the customer will be taken through the completion of the form by a GPW representative. Where a customer walks into GPW with a stack of hard copy notices delivered by a messenger on behalf of a newspaper the messenger must be referred back to the sender as the submission does not adhere to the submission rules.
- 5. All notice submissions that do not comply with point 2 will be charged full price for the notice submission.
- 6. The current cut-off of all Gazette's remains unchanged for all channels. (Refer to the GPW website for submission deadlines <u>www.gpwonline.co.za</u>)
- 7. Incorrectly completed forms and notices submitted in the wrong format will be rejected to the customer to be corrected and resubmitted. Assistance will be available through the Contact Centre should help be required when completing the forms. (012-748 6200 or email <u>info.egazette@gpw.gov.za</u>)
- 8. All re-submissions by customers will be subject to the above cut-off times.
- 9. All submissions and re-submissions that miss the cut-off will be rejected to the customer to be submitted with a new publication date.
- 10. Information on forms will be taken as the primary source of the notice to be published. Any instructions that are on the email body or covering letter that contradicts the notice form content will be ignored.

You are therefore advised that effective from **Monday**, **18 May 2015** should you not comply with our new rules of engagement, all notice requests will be rejected by our new system.

Furthermore, the fax number **012-748 6030** will also be <u>discontinued</u> from this date and customers will only be able to submit notice requests through the email address <u>submit.egazette@gpw.gov.za</u>.

DO use the new Adobe Forms for your notice request.

These new forms can be found on our website: www.gpwonline.co.za under the Gazette Services page.

DO attach documents separately in your email to GPW. (In other words, your email should have an Adobe Form plus proof of payment – 2 separate attachments - where notice content is applicable, it should also be a 3rd separate attachment)

DO specify your requested publication date.

DO send us the electronic Adobe form. (There is no need to print and scan it).

DON'T submit request as a single PDF containing all other documents, i.e. form, proof of payment & notice content, it will be FAILED by our new system.

DON'T print and scan the electronic Adobe form.

DON'T send queries or RFQ's to the submit.egazette mailbox.

DON'T send bad quality documents to GPW. (Check that documents are clear and can be read)

CALL FOR THE REGISTRATION OF PRIVATE ADULT EDUCATION AND TRAINING CENTRES AS PRIVATE COLLEGES UNDER THE CONTINUING EDUCATION AND TRAINING ACT NO. 16 OF 2006 AS AMENDED

I, Bonginkosi Emmanuel Nzimande, MP, Minister of Higher Education and Training hereby publish in terms of Section 25(3)(b) of the Further Education and Training Colleges Amendment Act No. 1 of 2013 a Notice inviting Private Adult Education and Training Centres (Private AET) that were previously registered with the various Provincial Education Departments (PEDs) as private AET centres as at 31 March 2015 in terms of the Adult Education and Training Act No. 52 of 2000 to apply for registration as private colleges with the Department of Higher Education and Training in terms of the Continuing Education and Training Act No. 16 of 2006 as amended.

In terms of the same Section 25(3)(b) of the Further Education and Training Colleges Amendment Act No. 1 of 2013, I hereby determine the transitional period within which all private AET centres cited above must have been registered as private colleges in terms of the Continuing Education and Training Act No. 16 of 2006 as amended, as commencing on 1 April 2015 until 31 March 2017. During this transitional period all private AET centres cited above are deemed as provisionally registered, subject to them meeting the requirements for registration as private colleges as contemplated in the Continuing Education and Training Act No. 16 of 2006 as amended.

The same call for registration as private colleges is hereby made to all other private AET centres that were not registered with the PEDs as at 31 March 2015, including prospective private AET centres. No private centres or institutions offering qualifications or part qualifications on the General and Further Education and Training Framework of the National Qualifications Framework may operate without registration under the Continuing Education and Training Act No. 16 of 2006 as amended.

Section 29 of the Continuing Education and Training Act No. 16 of 2006 as amended, provides that the Registrar of Private Colleges determines the manner and form in which applications for registration are made.

SUNSET REVIEW OF THE ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON CLEAR DRAWN AND FLOAT GLASS ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA (CHINA) AND INDIA: FINAL DETERMINATION

In accordance with the provisions in the Anti-Dumping Regulations (ADR), any definitive anti-dumping duty shall be terminated on a date not later than five years from the date of imposition, unless the authorities determine, in a review initiated before that date on their own initiative or upon a duly substantiated request made by or on behalf of the domestic industry, that the expiry of the duty would likely lead to the continuation and/or recurrence of dumping and injury.

On 20 June 2014, the Commission notified the SACU industry through notice No. 450 in the Government Gazette No. 37740, that unless a substantiated request is made by it indicating that the expiry of the anti-dumping duties on the subject product originating in or imported from China and India would likely lead to the continuation or recurrence of dumping and injury, the anti-dumping duties on the subject product originating in or imported from China and India would expire on 25 March 2015.

On 20 February 2015, the Commission initiated a sunset review of the anti-dumping duties on clear float and drawn glass originating in or imported from China and India through Notice No.151 published in the Government Gazette No. 38478.

The application was lodged by PFG Building Glass (the Applicant). The Applicant is the only producer of clear float glass in the Southern African Customs Union (SACU).

The investigation was initiated after the Commission considered that the expiry of the antidumping duties on imports of clear float and drawn glass originating in or imported from China and India would likely lead to the continuation or recurrence of dumping and injury. On initiation of the investigation, the known producers/exporters of the subject product in China and India were sent foreign manufacturers/exporters questionnaires to complete. Importers of the subject product were also sent questionnaires to complete. No properly documented responses were received from any interested party.

After considering all interested parties' comments, the Commission made a final determination that the expiry of the anti-dumping duties on clear float and drawn glass originating in or imported from China and India would likely lead to the continuation or recurrence of dumping and material injury.

The Commission therefore made a final determination to recommend to the Minister of Trade and Industry that the anti-dumping duties be maintained.

The Minister approved the Commission's recommendation. The Commission's detailed reasons for its decision are set out in its Report No. 504 (Final determination report).
