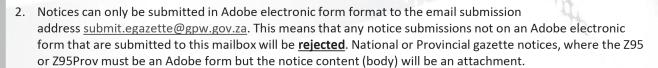
Dear Valued Customers,

Government Printing Works has implemented rules for completing and submitting the electronic Adobe Forms when you, the customer, submits your notice request.

Please take note of these guidelines when completing your form.

#### **GPW Business Rules**

1. No hand written notices will be accepted for processing, this includes Adobe forms which have been completed by hand.



- 3. Notices brought into GPW by "walk-in" customers on electronic media can only be submitted in Adobe electronic form format. This means that any notice submissions not on an Adobe electronic form that are submitted by the customer on electronic media will be <u>rejected</u>. National or Provincial gazette notices, where the Z95 or Z95Prov must be an Adobe form but the notice content (body) will be an attachment.
- 4. All customers who walk in to GPW that wish to submit a notice that is not on an electronic Adobe form will be routed to the Contact Centre where the customer will be taken through the completion of the form by a GPW representative. Where a customer walks into GPW with a stack of hard copy notices delivered by a messenger on behalf of a newspaper the messenger must be referred back to the sender as the submission does not adhere to the submission rules.
- 5. All notice submissions that do not comply with point 2 will be charged full price for the notice submission.
- 6. The current cut-off of all Gazette's remains unchanged for all channels. (Refer to the GPW website for submission deadlines <a href="https://www.gpwonline.co.za">www.gpwonline.co.za</a>)
- 7. Incorrectly completed forms and notices submitted in the wrong format will be rejected to the customer to be corrected and resubmitted. Assistance will be available through the Contact Centre should help be required when completing the forms. (012-748 6200 or email <a href="info.egazette@gpw.gov.za">info.egazette@gpw.gov.za</a>)
- 8. All re-submissions by customers will be subject to the above cut-off times.
- 9. All submissions and re-submissions that miss the cut-off will be rejected to the customer to be submitted with a new publication date.
- 10. Information on forms will be taken as the primary source of the notice to be published. Any instructions that are on the email body or covering letter that contradicts the notice form content will be ignored.

You are therefore advised that effective from **Monday**, **18 May 2015** should you not comply with our new rules of engagement, all notice requests will be rejected by our new system.

Furthermore, the fax number **012-748 6030** will also be <u>discontinued</u> from this date and customers will only be able to submit notice requests through the email address <u>submit.egazette@gpw.gov.za.</u>









**DO** use the new Adobe Forms for your notice request. These new forms can be found on our website: <a href="https://www.gpwonline.co.za">www.gpwonline.co.za</a> under the Gazette Services page.

**DO** attach documents separately in your email to GPW. (In other words, your email should have an Adobe Form plus proof of payment – 2 separate attachments – where notice content is applicable, it should also be a 3<sup>rd</sup> separate attachment)

**DO** specify your requested publication date.

**DO** send us the electronic Adobe form. (There is no need to print and scan it).



**DON'T** submit request as a single PDF containing all other documents, i.e. form, proof of payment & notice content, it will be **FAILED** by our new system.

**DON'T** print and scan the electronic Adobe form.

**DON'T** send queries or RFQ's to the submit.egazette mailbox.

**DON'T** send bad quality documents to GPW. (Check that documents are clear and can be read)

#### **Form Completion Rules**

No.	Rule Description	Explanation/example
1.	All forms must be completed in the chosen language.	GPW does not take responsibility for translation of notice content.
2.	All forms must be completed in sentence case, i.e. No fields should be completed in all uppercase.	e.g. "The company is called XYZ Production Works"
3.	No single line text fields should end with any punctuation, unless the last word is an abbreviation.	e.g. "Pty Ltd.", e.g. Do not end an address field, company name, etc. with a period (.) comma (,) etc.
4.	Multi line fields should not have additional hard returns at the end of lines or the field itself.	This causes unwanted line breaks in the final output, e.g.  • <u>Do not</u> type as: 43 Bloubokrand Street Putsonderwater 1923 • <u>Text should be entered</u> as: 43 Bloubokrand Street, Putsonderwater, 1923
5. REQUEST FOR THE CONTINUATION OF STATUTORY MEASURES IN THE SOUTH AFRICAN MILK INDUSTRY (REGISTRATION AND RECORDS & RETURNS) IN TERMS OF THE MARKETING OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS ACT, 1996 (ACT NO 47 OF 1996), AS AMENDED

It is hereby made known that in terms of section 11 of the Marketing of Agricultural Products Act, 1996 (Act No.47 of 1996), that the Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries has received a request from the milk industry for the continuation of statutory measures in the milk industry.

Milk Producers' Organisation (MPO), on behalf of the directly affected groups in the milk industry has applied for the continuation of statutory measures relating to registration, the keeping of records and rendering of returns. The current statutory measures in the milk industry will lapse on 1 November 2015. The MPO requested ministerial approval for the continuation of these statutory measures for a new period of four years, until 1 November 2019. The statutory measures will relate to milk which is defined in the Agricultural Product Standards Act as"the normal secretion of the mammary glands of bovines, goats and sheep".

The purpose and aim of the statutory measure relating to registration is to compel the milk producers of the Republic of South Africa to register with the MPO. The registration of milk producers will assist the industry to liaise with them regarding matters of concern such as legislation, training courses and technology transfer. This will also facilitate the maintenance of a national data base which is a prerequisite for the publication of reliable industry statistics.

The purpose and aim of the statutory measure relating to records & returns is to provide a statutory mechanism for milk producers to keep records and furnish returns to the MPO. It will be expected from each milk producer, within 15 days after 31 October of each year, to furnish accurate returns to the MPO. This is deemed necessary to ensure that continuous, timeous and accurate statistics and information relating to the dairy farming industry is made available to all role-players. Recordkeeping of the dairy cattle population will create statistics per province and districts of the number of cows, bulls, heifers and breeds. It will then be possible to follow changing population trends per province in order for the industry to predict milk production trends. The monitoring of trends of herd sizes and dairy breeds as well as the location thereof will assist the industry in the steering of its educational, research, extension and health programmes.

According to the applicant (MPO), the proposed continuation of the statutory measures will further the objectives of the MAP Act as stipulated in section 2(2) thereof. Such establishment will also not contravene section 2(3) of the Act, namely will not be substantially detrimental to food security, the number of employment opportunities within the economy or fair labour practices. The objectives referred to in section 2(2) of the Act are to increase market access for all market participants, to promote the efficiency of marketing of agricultural products, to optimise export earnings from agricultural products and to enhance the viability of the agricultural sector.

The institution that will be responsible for the administration of the statutory measures is the MPO. The MPO is a voluntary producer organisation and is registered in terms of Article 21 of the Companies Act and is a non-profit company in terms of the Companies Act, 2008 (Act No.71 of 2008). It has the required capacity in terms of personnel, infrastructure and skills to administer the statutory measures.

The NAMC took cognisance that the proposed continuation of the statutory measures as requested by the MPO is consistent with the objectives of the Marketing of Agricultural Products Act, 1996 (Act no 47 of 1996), as amended. The request is being investigated by the NAMC and recommendations in this regard will be made to the Minister in the near future.

Directly affected groups in the milk industry are kindly requested to submit any comments regarding the proposed continuation of statutory measures to the National Agricultural Marketing Council within 14 days of the publication hereof.

A regulatory body established as a juristic person in terms of the provisions of section 19 of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998, as amended ("Competition Act"), herein duly represented by Mr Tembinkosl Bonakele in his capacity as the Commissioner of the Competition Commission

## and

# THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE ADMINISTRATION COMMISSION OF SOUTH AFRICA

(Hereinafter referred to as "ITAC")

A body of authority established as a juristic person in terms of the International Trade Administration Act No. 71 of 2002,

herein duly represented by Mr Siyabulela Tsengiwe, in his capacity as the Chief

Commissioner of ITAC

### 1. PREAMBLE

The Competition Commission is established in terms of section 19 of the Competition Act in order to promote and maintain competition in South Africa through, *inter alia*, investigation and evaluation of restrictive vertical and horizontal practices, abuse of a dominant position, complex monopoly conduct, exemptions, mergers and acquisitions, and conducting market inquiries.

The Competition Commission, in terms of the provisions of section 21(1)(h) read with sections 3(1A)(a) and 3(1A)(b) and 82(1) of the Competition Act may negotiate agreements with any regulatory authority in order to coordinate and harmoniss the exercise of concurrent jurisdiction exercised over competition matters (Chapter 2, 2A,3 or 4A of the Competition Act) within a relevant industry or sector, and to ensure the consistent application of the principles of the Competition Act. Furthermore, the Competition Commission may in terms of section 21(1)(i) participate in the proceedings of any regulatory authority and in terms of section 21(1)(j) advise and receive advice from any regulatory authority.

ITAC is established in terms of section 7(1) of the International Trade Administration Act in order to administer international trade in terms of section 26 of the International Trade Administration Act by investigating and evaluating applications concerning alleged dumped or subsidised imports; safeguard measures and the amendment of customs duties in South Africa and within the Common Customs Area.

ITAC may in terms of section 21(1)(a) of the International Trade Administration Act enter into an agreement with any regulatory authority or organ of state to coordinate and harmonise their respective functions with regard to international trade matters, in order to ensure the achievement of the objects of the International Trade Administration Act. ITAC may in terms of section 21(3) participate in the proceedings of any regulatory authority or organ of state and advise and receive advice from, any regulatory authority or organ of state.

There are thus areas of common interest and functions that call for cooperation between the Parties.

# 2. THE OBJECTIVE OF THE AGREEMENT

The purpose of this Agreement is to promote cooperation and friendly relations between the Parties on matters of mutual interest in order to give effect to their respective governing legislation.

### 3. COOPERATION

The Parties hereby agree on cooperation as meaning the following:

- 3.1 Operation of and participation in joint education programmes;
- 3.2 Providing comment/advice on complaints/applications; and
- 3.3 Providing comment/advice on merger transactions.

# 4. JOINT EDUCATION PROGRAMMES

The Parties agree, to the extent feasible:

- 4.1 To co-sponsor joint workshops or seminars on competition and international trade matters as and when necessary on any topical matter of mutual interest;
- 4.2 To conduct joint impact assessment studies; alternatively sector research studies and/or make contributions in each other's impact assessment studies.

# 5. COMPLAINTS/APPLICATIONS

The Parties agree, to the extent feasible:

- 5.1 To make representations to each other on matters relating to complaints/applications falling within their respective jurisdictions where they deem it necessary for the other to take into account such competition/international trade considerations in resolving complaints/applications;
- 5.2 To refer complaints/applications falling within the jurisdiction of the other within a reasonable time after the review of such and also to advise the complainant(s) to lodge/submit such complaints/submissions, as the case may be, with/to the relevant authority; and
- 5.3 To advise and receive advice from one another, in particular for ITAC to provide the Competition Commission with an opportunity to comment on applications as the case is with other stakeholders.

### 6. MERGER TRANSACTIONS

If in analysing a merger transaction the Competition Commission is of the view that there are international trade regulatory issues subject to the jurisdiction of ITAC, the Competition Commission may consult with ITAC to obtain input on such international trade issues pertaining to the transaction.

# 7. EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION

The Parties shall endeavour to ensure that any information sharing or exchange; will not breach any confidentiality restrictions in terms of their respective mandate(s) and will be conducted only as is necessary to give effect to this Agreement and each entity shall keep records of all information so exchanged between them.

### 8. CONFIDENTIALITY

Any information shared by the Parties pursuant to this Agreement shall be used only for lawful purposes. Parties shall therefore treat confidential information shared between them as such and to be used only for the purpose of conducting their respective regulatory mandates.

# 9. GENERAL PROVISIONS

This Agreement is entered into on the basis of the spirit of cooperation and goodwill; and does not affect the independence of the Parties hereto. The provision of or request for information under this Agreement *may* therefore be denied:

- 9.1 Where compliance would require either of the Parties to act in violation of the law;
- 9.2 Under circumstances where there is an imminent risk to national security; or
- 9.3 When compliance with a request or provision of information would interfere with an ongoing investigation in circumstances where prejudice to the investigation is likely to outweigh the adverse effects of denying the information.

# 10. VARIATION OF THE AGREEMENT

Any variation of this Agreement shall have no legal effect and shall not be binding on the Parties unless reduced to writing and signed by persons authorised to act on behalf of both the Parties.

# 11. COMMENCEMENT OF THE AGREEMENT

This Agreement will commence:

- 11.1 On the date of signature thereof by the Party last to sign it and shall endure until termination thereof in accordance with Clause 12 (Termination).
- 11.2 It has been published in the Government Gazette.

# 12. DURATION AND TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall remain in force until it is changed or repealed by both Parties hereto, acting jointly or upon any of the Parties giving the other party a notice of termination of no less than thirty (30) busines**s** days.

**LANGUAGE POLICY** 

### 1. DEFINITIONS

- 1.1 In this Policy, unless the context indicates otherwise-
  - 1.1.1 "Constitution" means the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act, 1996 (Act No. 108 of 1996);
  - 1.1.2 "Language Unit" means the language unit to be established by TETA in terms of this Policy;
  - 1.1.3 "TETA" means Transport Education and Training Authority, a public entity established as such in terms of the laws of the Republic of South Africa;
  - 1.1.4 "Translator" means a person who shall be responsible for transferring the meaning of written text/documents etc from one language to another in order to accommodate four languages which are English, Xhosa, iSizulu, and Sepedi.

# 2. PURPOSE

- 2.1 To enhance the status and use of official languages;
- 2.2 To promote the equitable use of 4 (four) official languages;
- 2.3 To facilitate equitable access to the services provided by TETA in terms of knowledge and information;
- 2.4 To encourage the learning of other official indigenous languages;
- 2.5 To promote good language management for efficient service administration to meet stakeholder/customer expectations and needs;
- 2.6 To encourage stakeholders/customers to free themselves from all forms of linguistic discrimination, domination and division to enable them to exercise appropriate linguistic choices.

## 3. PRINCIPLES

- 3.1 This language policy is based on the following principles:-
  - 3.1.1 Effective communication within a framework of multilingualism;

- 3.1.2 Equity and language rights as outlined in the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa;
  3.1.3 Preventing the use of any language for the purposes of exploitation, domination and discrimination;
  3.1.4 Enhancing people-centeredness in addressing the interests, needs and aspirations of a wide range of language communities through different knowledge platforms;
  3.1.5 Facilitating internal and external business communication language(s);
- 3.1.6 Viewing multilingualism as a resource; and
- 3.1.7 Redressing marginalization of indigenous languages.

### 4. LEGISLATIVE CONTEXT

- 4.1 The Constitution of the Republic of South Africa guarantees equal status to 11 official languages, on the grounds that their usage includes about 98% of the total population. The 11 official languages are, amongst others, English, Xhosa, iSizulu, and Sepedi;
- 4.2 Section 6 of the Constitution provides the principal legal framework for multilingualism, the development of the official languages and the promotion of respect and tolerance for South Africa's linguistic diversity.
- 4.3 The Constitution emphasizes that 11 (eleven) official languages must "enjoy parity of esteem" and be treated equitably, thereby enhancing the status and use of indigenous languages, with government taking "legislative and other measures" to regulate and monitor the use of disadvantaged indigenous languages. The Constitution mandates change to the language situation throughout the country, giving social and political recognition to hitherto disadvantaged language groups on the basis of the expressed needs of communities and interest groups.
- 4.4 Pan South African Languages Board Act, 1995 (Act No. 59 of 1995) aims to promote multilingualism in South Africa in order to develop the country's eleven languages equally.
- 4.5 The Use of Official Languages Act, 2012 (Act No. 12 of 2012) was promulgated and adopted to regulate the use of official languages by Government.

## SCOPE AND PROVISION OF THE LANGUAGE POLICY

- 5.1 This Policy is applicable to all of TETA's communication and knowledge platforms, services and products.
- 5.2 TETA promotes multilingualism and designates English, Xhosa, iSizulu, and Sepedi as its primary languages for administrative, communication and marketing purposes.

### 6. IMPLEMENTATION STRUCTURES AND MECHANISMS

- 6.1 Section 4(1) of the Use of Languages Act 2012, read together with Section 6(2) of the Constitution, requires mechanisms to be put in place to develop official languages. Thus certain structures and mechanisms are proposed to enhance effective implementation of the language policy.
- 6.2 These tools are essential in managing the use of languages, coordinating language development projects, professionalizing and advocating the role of language services and developing human resources.

### 7. LANGUAGE UNIT

A Language Unit is established within the organization. The Language Unit is responsible for the following:-

- 7.1. Entrenching the Language Policy within the organisation;
- 7.2 Raising awareness of the Language Policy within the organisation;
- 7.3 Managing and facilitating all translation and editing services, either in-house or outsourced;
- 7.4 Proof reading and printing documents in the 4 official languages;
- 7.5 Facilitating the use of interpreting services in the official languages;
- 7.6 Advising TETA on language use (oral and written);
- 7.7 Managing and facilitating training programmes for new recruits in translation and editing, language programmes, terminology development, a language code of conduct and language awareness campaigns.

# 8. TRANSLATED DOCUMENTS

The following documents must be translated into languages as referred to in 5.2 above, because it is imperative that the stakeholder/customer knows and understands the contents thereof, as they give rise to contractual liability and other legal implications:

- 8.1 Discretionary Grant Policy;
- 8.2 Mandatory Grant Policy;
- 8.3 TETA Constitution:
- 8.4 Bursary Policy;
- 8.5 Small Business Development Strategy.

# 9. MARKETING AND ADVERTISING

The forms of marketing and advertising tools used by TETA are:

- 9.1 Radio Adverts: They shall be in accordance with the proposed language as listed in 5.2 above.
- 9.2 Flyers: They shall be in accordance with the proposed language as listed in 5.2 above..
- 9.3 *Information Brochures:* They shall be in accordance with the proposed language as listed in 5.2 above.
- 9.4 **Print Advertising:** They shall be in accordance with the proposed language as listed in 5.2 above.
- 9.5 *Digital and Television:* They shall be in accordance with the proposed language as listed in 5.2 above
- 9.6 Public Address and Direct Marketing: They shall be in accordance with the proposed language as listed in 5.2 above..

# 10. FINANCIAL AND LEGAL TERMINOLOGY

TETA anticipates that it may experience problems in the translation of specialized financial and legal terminology into other languages, resulting in concerns that the documents will not have necessary legal standing in South Africa. TETA has therefore adopted a stance that any documentation requiring stakeholder/customer's signature will be obtained in the English version only, however, stakeholders/customers will be provided with the translated document in the languages of their choice (limited to the 4 adopted languages) and be offered the opportunity to be clarified where they do not understand.

# 11. VIOLATION REPORTING

- 11.1 All violations of the Language Policy shall be reported to the relevant senior manager.
- All employees are expected to comply with the terms and conditions of employment as prescribed in their employment contracts. Any employee violating approved policies and procedures including the Language Policy shall be dealt with in accordance with the internal disciplinary process or any legal process as deemed appropriate by the management of TETA.
- 11.3 The escalation procedure for this policy shall be as follows:
  - 11.3.1 When a violation of the policy is reported or noted, the employee or entity concerned shall be requested to rectify the violation immediately.
  - 11.3.2 Should the violation continue the next escalation level would be to the accountable Executive.
