

GPW Business Rules

1. No hand written notices will be accepted for processing, this includes Adobe forms which have been completed by hand.



- 3. Notices brought into GPW by "walk-in" customers on electronic media can only be submitted in Adobe electronic form format. This means that any notice submissions not on an Adobe electronic form that are submitted by the customer on electronic media will be <u>rejected</u>. National or Provincial gazette notices, where the Z95 or Z95Prov must be an Adobe form but the notice content (body) will be an attachment.
- 4. All customers who walk in to GPW that wish to submit a notice that is not on an electronic Adobe form will be routed to the Contact Centre where the customer will be taken through the completion of the form by a GPW representative. Where a customer walks into GPW with a stack of hard copy notices delivered by a messenger on behalf of a newspaper the messenger must be referred back to the sender as the submission does not adhere to the submission rules.
- 5. All notice submissions that do not comply with point 2 will be charged full price for the notice submission.
- 6. The current cut-off of all Gazette's remains unchanged for all channels. (Refer to the GPW website for submission deadlines www.gpwonline.co.za)
- 7. Incorrectly completed forms and notices submitted in the wrong format will be rejected to the customer to be corrected and resubmitted. Assistance will be available through the Contact Centre should help be required when completing the forms. (012-748 6200 or email info.egazette@gpw.gov.za)
- 8. All re-submissions by customers will be subject to the above cut-off times.

ESTABLISHMENT OF SMALL CLAIMS COURTS FOR THE AREAS OF CHRISTIANA, WARRENTON AND HARTSWATER AND WITHDRAWAL OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 603 OF 8 AUGUST 2014

- I, John Harold Jeffery, Deputy Minister of Justice and Constitutional Development, acting under the power delegated to me by the Minister of Justice and Correctional Services, under section 2 of the Small Claims Courts Act, 1984 (Act No. 61 of 1984), hereby -
 - (a) (i) establish a Small Claims Court for the adjudication of claims for the area of Christiana, consisting of the district of Christiana;
 - (ii) determine Christiana to be the seat of the said Court; and
 - (iii) determine Christiana to be the place in that area for the holding of sessions of the said Court.
 - (b) (i) establish a Small Claims Court for the adjudication of claims for the area of Warrenton, consisting of the district of Warrenton;
 - (ii) determine Warrenton to be the seat of the said Court; and
 - (iii) determine Warrenton to be the place in that area for the holding of sessions of the said Court.
 - (c) (i) establish a Small Claims Court for the adjudication of claims for the area of Hartswater, consisting of the district of Hartswater;
 - (ii) determine Hartswater to be the seat of the said Court; and
 - (iii) determine Hartswater to be the place in that area for the holding of sessions of the said Court.
 - (c) withdraw Government Notice No. 603 of 8 August 2014.

Despite the withdrawal of Government Notice No. 603 of 8 August 2014, any claim emanating from the district of Hartswater which has already been instituted in the Small Claims Court of Warrenton, (previously known as Southern Harts), prior to the publication of this Government Notice, shall be continued and concluded in the Small Claims Court of Warrenton as if this Government Notice has not been published.
