Johannesburg - The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice that it will hold public hearings in respect of the notice of intention to conduct an inquiry into number portability regulations as published on 26 August 2016, Government Gazette No: 40232.

1. The objective to conduct an inquiry into number portability regulations is to:
 - 1.1. determine the strengths and weakness of the current number portability framework;
 - 1.2. determine if there are regulatory gaps arising from the market and regulatory development; and

- 1.3. determine the impact of the current number portability framework on licensees and the general public.
