10. Key points

- 1.1. The affordability assessment requirements of the wea codes in the credit code were established. The following principles were established:
- (a) credit should be extended to consumers only if the credit provider has been verified or validated;
 - (b) credit providers should verify the credit consumers' ability to repay;
 - (c) minimum living expense credit limit for credit consumers;
 - (d) consistency of consumer's income and expenses.

These principles form the basis of the following regulations:

- 1.2. Regulation 23A(12)(a) states that credit providers calculate the consumer's discretionary income, less statutory deductions, such as financial institution payments, necessary expenses and other deductions including such as may appear from the consumer's bank statement, the amount available to fund the proposed credit.
- 1.3. Discretionary Income is that part of the consumer's income available to fund the proposed credit agreement after making a provision for all the above-mentioned items.
- 1.4. Regulation 23A(8) requires credit providers to verify discretionary income by deducting the following from the consumer's gross income:
- (a) statutory deductions;
 - (b) financial institution payments;
 - (c) necessary expenses;
 - (d) other deductions.
- 1.5. Regulation 23A(9) requires credit providers to verify monthly gross income with reference to the consumer's bank statement. The regulation requires credit providers to verify the following to consumers:
- (a) the consumer's gross income;
 - (b) the consumer's necessary expenses, broken down by the categories of consumers; Regulation 23A(10)(a) requires credit providers to obtain expense norms applicable to the consumer's category of consumers;
 - (c) the consumer's discretionary income, as determined by the court in *Treworcks & Another v Minister of Trade and Industry and Others*; and
 - (d) the consumer's gross income, less the consumer's necessary expenses, as determined by the court in *Treworcks & Another v Minister of Trade and Industry and Others*.

11. Verification

- 2.1. Credit providers should ascertain the consumer's ability to repay before extending credit to consumers. This is required by regulation 23A(11)(a).
- 2.2. The gross income of a consumer will normally be ascertained by reference to such consumer's bank statement. If the consumer's salary is deposited in a bank account, the consumer's living expenses and other obligations will be ascertained by reference to the consumer's bank statement. In order to establish the consistency of the consumer's income, three (3) months' bank statements or payslips should be obtained by credit providers. For this category of consumers, credit providers can use either payslips or bank statements to calculate the consumers' discretionary incomes.
- 2.3. Where the consumer has been employed for less than three (3) months, the credit provider should obtain the consumer's latest payslip at the time of the credit application, or a letter of employment confirmation from the employer detailing the salary and its frequency of payment or a bank statement showing the latest salary deposit.

2.4. For consumers who are self-employed or do not have formal employment and who do not have income such as other verifications of the means of payment of the consumer's payment obligations, credit providers should use affordability assessment models approved by the NCR.

2.5. For consumers referred to in paragraph 2.4, credit providers should determine whether the consumer has a bank account and whether the

consumer has other income other than from formal employment. Credit providers should use the affordability model of income sufficient to meet obligations. The credit provider must submit its list of consumers in each category of consumers to the NCR.

2.6. Credit providers should inform the consumer whether the consumer is creditworthy.

3. Application

3.1. These guidelines apply to credit providers who wish to ascertain consumers' creditworthiness.

3.2. Credit providers should use the guidelines to determine creditworthiness in assessments on credit applications.




