

NATIONAL ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1996 (ACT NO. 93 OF 1996)

DETERMINATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CURRICULA FOR TRAFFIC OFFICERS

I, Dr B.E Nzimande, Minister of Transport acting in terms of section 75 of the National Road Traffic Act, 1996 (Act No.93 of 1996) read with regulation 2B(3) of the National Road Traffic Regulations, 2000 hereby determine and implement the curriculum for traffic officers approved by the Quality Council for Trades and Occupations and registered under registration: South African Qualification Identity number, 97639 with effect from 1 November 2018: Provided that any traffic officer's qualification obtained from a Training Centre referred to in section 3D (1) (a) of the National Road Traffic Act, 1996 (Act No.93 of 1996) prior to 1 July 2020 shall be recognised.
