1. SCOPE OF APPLICATION OF AGREEMENT

- (1) The terms of this agreement will be observed in the tanning section of the leather industry -
 - (a) in the Republic of South Africa,
 - (b) by **all** employers who are members of the employers' organisation, and by **all** employees who are members of the trade unions, and who are engaged or employed in the said section of the industry.
- (2) The terms of this Agreement will apply only to employees for whom wages are prescribed in terms of this agreement, and to employers of such employees.
- (3) The terms of this agreement will not apply to non parties in respect of clauses 1 (1)(b) and 2 (1)

2. DATE AND PERIOD OF OPERATION

- 1) This Agreement will come into operation for the parties on 1 July 2018 and remain in force for the period ending 30 June 2021.
- 2) This Agreement will come into operation for non-parties on such date as the Minister of Labour extends the agreement to them, and will remain in force for the period ending 30 June 2021.

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3. CLAUSE 7: REMUNERATION

7.1 Wages and Wage Rates






(Hereinafter referred to as the employees or the trade unions) of the other part, being the parties to the National Bargaining Council of the Leather Industry of South Africa, to amend the Agreement for the General Goods and Handbag Sector, published under Government Notices No. R 1193 of 17 December 2010, R 524 of 24 June 2011, R.1018 of 7 December 2011, R 885 of 2 November 2012, R.771 of 18 October 2013, R.790 of 17 October 2014, R 1044 of 30 October 2015, R 765 of 24 June 2016, R.1280 of 21 October 2016 and 758 of 29 September 2017.



1. CLAUSE 1 - SCOPE OF APPLICATION OF AGREEMENT

- (1) The terms of this agreement shall be observed in the General Goods and Handbag Section of the Leather Industry
 - (a) in the Republic of South Africa,
 - (b) by all employers who are members of the employer organisation. and by all employees who are members of the trade unions who are engaged or employed in the General Goods and Handbag sectors of the Leather Industry respectively.
- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subclause (1) the terms of this agreement shall apply only to employees for whom wages are prescribed in Annexure C to the agreement, and to the employers of such employees.
- (3) The terms of this agreement shall not apply to non parties in respect of Clauses 1(1)(b) and 2(1).

2. CLAUSE 2 - DATE AND PERIOD OF OPERATION

- (1) This agreement shall come into operation for the parties on 1 July 2018 and remain in force for the period ending 30 June 2021
- (2) This agreement shall come into operation for non-parties on such date as the Minister of Labour extends the agreement to non-parties and shall remain in force for the period ending 30 June 2021.

2. PROPORTION AND RATIO OF EMPLOYEES

(1) Travelling requisites -

- (a) Not less than one foreman shall be employed in every establishment.
- (b) In each of the wage categories listed in paragraphs (i), (ii), (iii), (iv), (v) and (vi) of subclause (c) not more than one learner may be employed for every qualified employee employed in that category

(2) Saddlery -

- (a) Not less than one foreman shall be employed in every establishment.
- (b) In each of the wage categories listed in paragraphs (ii), (iii), (iv), (v) and (vi) of subclause (C), not more than one learner may be employed for every qualified employee employed in that category.

(3) Harness -

- (a) Not less than one foreman shall be employed in each establishment.
- (b) For each employee receiving a wage of not less than R1114.09 per week during the period ending 30 June 2019, not more than one employee may be employed at a wage less than R1114.09. Provided that general workers shall not be taken into consideration when determining the number of such employees that may be employed.

(4) Braces -

For each employee receiving a wage of not less than R1114.09 per week during the period ending 30 June 2019, not more than one employee may be employed at a wage less than R1114.09 per week during the period ending 30 June 2019: Provided that general workers shall not be taken into consideration when determining the number of such employees that may be employed.

(5) Personal Goods -


For each employee receiving a wage of not less than R1114.09 per week during the period ending 30 June 2019, not more than one employee may be employed at a wage less than R1114.09 per week during the period ending 30 June 2019. Provided that general workers shall not be taken into consideration when determining the number of such employees that may be employed.



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(6) Handbags –

- (a) Not less than one foreman shall be employed in each *establishment*.
- (b) The number of learners employed in each *establishment* shall not exceed three such employees to every two qualified employees employed in such *establishment*.
- (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subclause (1), the following departmental ratios shall be observed
- (i) Cutting Department - Not more than three learner cutters shall be employed to every two qualified cutters employed in each *establishment*
 - (ii) Machining Department - Not more than three learner machinists shall be employed to every two qualified machinists employed in each *establishment*
 - (iii) Handbag framing department - Not more than three learners handbag framers shall be employed to every two qualified handbag framers employed in each *establishment*

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

NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 39 (1)(b) OF THE NATIONAL LAND TRANSPORT ACT NO.5 OF 2009: MORATORIUM REGARDING THE GRANTING OF NEW OPERATING LICENCES BY THE NORTH WEST PROVINCIAL REGULATORY ENTITY (PRE).

I Dr MOKGANTSHANG NICHOLAS MOTLHABANE, MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL responsible for transport matters in the Province, by virtue of the powers vested in me in terms of Section 39(1)(b) of the abovementioned Act, hereby declare a moratorium as follows:-


1. The Provincial Regularity Entity (PRE) shall not receive any applications for new Operating Licences in the Province with effect from 1/9/2018 and this moratorium shall remain in force until the date to be determined by the MEC and published in the Provincial notice.
2. The operation of the moratorium on the granting of the new operating licenses shall not exceed a period of (2) two years calculated from the date determined in the above mentioned provision. Other transactions like Additional Authority, Transfers, Increase of Passengers, Replacements, Renewal of Operating Licenses and Temporary Operating Licenses shall not be affected by the moratorium.
3. The operation of the moratorium shall also not affect the following applications;
 - (a) Staff Services
 - (b) Scholar transport services (both contracted and non – contracted)
 - (c) Contracted Services
 - (d) Shuttle Services
 - (e) Tourist Operations

All applications lodged before the coming into effect of the moratorium shall not be affected and shall therefore be processed accordingly.

4. In case where there are new settlements and a need for transport is identified, the affected Municipality should seek the necessary approval from the MEC to allow PRE to consider applications for those settlements.

The rationale for the moratorium is as follows;

- (a) To allow the Department to **conduct an audit process** of all operating licenses issued;
- (b) To **conduct physical verification of all operating licenses** issued in the North West Province with a view to stem out illegal operations;
- (c) To allow the Department an opportunity to **align all routes and put new operating conditions** on all operating licenses;
- (d) To allow for the finalization of the development of the **Intergrated Provincial Transport Network Plans** as well as the **Intergrated Transport Plans**.
