Rule 47.03 of the Rules under the Customs and Excise Act, 1964 (Act No. 91 of 1964), is hereby amended by the substitution in paragraph (a) for subparagraph (v) of the following subparagraph:

“(v) All other classes or kinds of alcoholic beverages not mentioned above, after a period of **[36]** 48 months, but within a period of **[48]** 60 months.”.
