DECLARATION OF THE GREY DELL AND FORT GREY FORESTS AREAS AS A NATURAL FOREST UNDER SECTION 7(2) OF THE NATIONAL FORESTS ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 84 OF 1998)

I, Barbara Dallas Creecy, Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, hereby declare, under section 7(2) of the National Forests Act, 1998 (Act No. 84 of 1998), to be a natural forest, all indigenous tree cover, in any stage of development, occurring on the indicated properties in the Grey Deli and Fort Grey Forests areas, set out in the Schedule hereto, with the incorporation of interspersed open land, degraded forest and planted forest serving as nursery crop.

Section 2(1) of the National Forest Act, 1998 (Act No. 84 of 1998) defines "forest" to include "the ecosystem which it makes up". It must be noted that the forest ecosystem on the indicated properties must be viewed as an integrated functioning ecosystem. These forests consist of a mossic of degraded and well-developed intact primary natural forest belonging to the type: Scarp Forest (VEGMAP type: FOz 5) which is seamlessly intermingled with Buffels Thicket (VEGMAP type: AT 12) and Albany Coestal Beit Thicket (VEGMAP type: AT 9) with possible interspersed elements of Southern Afrotemperate Forest (VEGMAP type FOz 1). Furthermore, it is recognized that ecological interface exists between forest and natural open vegetation in proximity to extend forest cover, as well as the small pockets of plantation of exotic species that provide extended habitat for some forest faune and a nursery forest stand.

The decignation is an urgent measure to prevent further deforestation due to lilegal activities and to enable forest rehabilitation in the affected areas. Due to illegal activities on the affected land, some of the natural tree cover had been degraded, so that contiguous canopy cover may no longer exist in parts, whereas some areas previously wooded may also now be completely denuded as a result of deforestation. Degradation due to invasion of exotic species also occurs.

The areas and properties that fall within the scope of the decignation are thus viewed as an integrated functioning ecceyetem, of which some parts have been degraded and deforested, and include all natural wooded land, interspersed open land and plantation patches on the designated properties.



DECLARATION OF THE GREY DELL AND FORT GREY FORESTS AREAS AS A CONTROLLED FOREST AREA UNDER SECTION 17(2) OF THE NATIONAL FORESTS ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 84 OF 1998)

I, Barbara Dalias Creecy, Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, hereby declare, under section 17(2) of the National Forests Act, 1998 (Act No. 84 of 1998), the Grey Deli and Fort Grey forest areas and associated land as a controlled forest area for the purposes of preventing deforestation and for rehabilitation of natural forest and associated habitat that was damaged and degraded. The background, effective period, description of the area, location, local municipality, prohibitions and steps to be taken by the owner of the land, as well as the properties that form part of the controlled forest area, are set out in the Schedule hereto.

PART A: BACKGROUND, EFFECTIVE PERIOD, DESCRIPTION OF THE AREA, LOCATION, LOCAL MUNICIPALITY, LAND OWNERSHIP, PROHIBITIONS AND STEPS TO BE TAKEN BY THE OWNER

Background:

The locality forms the principal part of the global distribution of an endemic tree species: Umitza listeriana. A number of rare forest fauna species also occur within this landacape of diverse types of forest cover. The conservation value of this area has long been recognized. The first portion of Fort Grey State forest was proclaimed prior to the Union of South Africa and subsequently expanded. Umitza Nature Reserve was declared within the Fort Grey State forest on 5 July 1985 (Government Notice No. 1453 in Government Gazette No. 9830 of 5 July 1985). In recent years an illegal settlement has sprung up in the proximity of this forest and has gradually encroached into the natural forest areas during the last decade. This encroaching informal settlement results in illegal harvesting of forest produce within the forest, degradation of the forest and in some parts have led to deforestation. This invasion of the forest threatens the future existence of the forest and priority species.

Effective time period:

The declaration will be valid for a period of 5 (five) years with effect from the date of publication of this Notice in the Government Gazette.

Description:

The description of the area to be declared is as follows:

The controlled forest area covers 1 858.48ha. It consists of natural forest that incorporates lesser areas of planted forest and open land. The natural vegetation consists of Scarp Forest (forest type: FOz 5); Buffels Thicket (type AT 12) and incorporate embedded portions of Albany Coastal Belt Thicket (type AT 9) as well as possible interspersed elements of Southern Afrotemperate Forest (type FOz 1). This vegetation mosaic functions as an integrated ecosystem with the natural forest.
