Explanatory Memorandum to the Provincial Allocations set out in the Schedules

This *Gazette* is published in terms of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021 (Act No. 9 of 2021), and provides information on adjustments to existing allocations to national departments and provinces in the 2021/22 financial year.

This is necessitated by the need to allocate a portion of an unallocated schedule 7, Part A grant to KwaZulu-Natal following storm damages experienced by the province.

This *Gazette* therefore updates information that was published in the Division of Revenue Act, 2021.

This notice affects the Provincial Emergency Housing Grant,

- a) In compliance with Section 25 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2021 the National Department of Human Settlements allocates R3.802 million to KwaZulu-Natal from the unallocated Provincial Emergency Housing Grant (Schedule 7, Part A).
